RESOLUTION OF THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE THREE AFFILIATED TRIBES OF THE FORT BERTHOLD RESERVATION

- WHEREAS, This Nation having accepted the Indian Reorganization Act of June 18, 1934, and the authority under said Act; and
- WHEREAS, The Constitution of the Three Affiliated Tribes generally authorizes and empowers the Tribal Business Council to engage in activities on behalf of and in the interest of the welfare and benefit of the Tribes and of the enrolled members thereof; and
- WHEREAS, chronic alcoholism and drug use are social problems on the reservation, and these problems are the basis for a great percentage of social ills that have plagued the Fort Berthold Reservation such as domestic abuse and driving under the influence, and
- WHEREAS, coordination of efforts, dissemination of relevant information, and collaboration of efforts is needed for potential problem solving by various service providers, and
- WHEREAS, more effort is needed in the adjudication process, sentence monitoring and compliance, court referred prevention, intervention, treatment and after-care support mechanisms,
- NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Three Affiliated Tribes hereby approves the application for the Drug Court Planning Grant.
- **BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED,** that the Three Affiliated Tribes requests funding for a drug court planning grant in the amount of \$30,000 pursuant to the drug court planning grant application.
