- WHEREAS, This Nations having accepted the Indian Reorganization Act of June 18, 1934 and the Authority under said Act; and
- WHEREAS, The Constitution of the Three Affiliated Tribes generally authorizes and empowers the Tribal Business Council to engage in activities on behalf of and in the interest of the welfare and benefit of the Tribes and of the enrolled members thereof, and
- WHEREAS, Article VI, Section 5 © of the Constitution of the Three Affiliated Tribes provides that the Tribal Business Council shall have the power to administer tribal funds and make expenditures; and
- WHEREAS, The Fort Berthold Girls Basketball Team requests \$250.00 per student with a maximum amount of \$3,000.00 to attend the All-West Native Basketball Classic and the 2nd Annual Native Youth First: The Future of Indian America Conference in Denver, Colorado. The conference dates are May 31 to June 4, 2000. The purpose of the conference is to demonstrate how native youth can have a voice in their future, enhance their lives, and the future of themselves and their culture.
- NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the Tribal Business Council of the Three Affiliated Tribes hereby authorizes \$3,000.00 for the Fort Berthold Girls Basketball Team to attend the Native Youth & Basketball Classic in Denver, Colorado.
