

**RESOLUTION OF THE GOVERNING BODY OF
THE THREE AFFILIATED TRIBES OF THE
FORT BERTHOLD RESERVATION**

WHEREAS, This Nation having accept the Indian Reorganization Act of June 18, 1934, and the authority under said Act; and

WHEREAS, The Constitution of the Three Affiliated Tribes generally authorizes and empowers the Tribal Business Council to engage in activities on behalf of and in the interest of the welfare and benefits of the Tribes and of the enrolled members thereof; and

WHEREAS, Article VI, Section (C), of the Constitution of the Three Affiliated Tribes specifically authorizes and empowers the Tribal Business Council to administer any funds or property within the exclusive control of the Tribes and to make expenditures from available Tribal funds for public purpose of the tribes; and

WHEREAS, LuJuanna LaCroix, an enrolled member, 301-U-00839, is requesting financial assistance in the form of a loan. The loan is to be amortized on a 9.50% APR payback plan with bi-weekly payments of \$50.00; and

WHEREAS, The amount requested is \$1,000.00 for a personal loan; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, That the Tribal Business Council does hereby approve a loan to LuJuanna LaCroix in the amount of \$1,000.00.

BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED, That the Tribal Business Council further directs the Small Loan Director to expedite the loan proceeds according to the terms outlined in this Resolution.


CERTIFICATION
