RESOLUTION OF THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE THREE AFFILIATED TRIBES OF THE FORT BERTHOLD INDIAN RESERVATION

- WHEREAS, This nation having accepted the Indian Reorganization Act of June 18, 1934 and the authority under said Act; and
- WHEREAS, The Constitution of the Three Affiliated Tribes does authorize and Empower the Tribal Business Council to enact laws on behalf of, and in the interest of the welfare and benefit of the Tribes and the enrolled members thereof; and
- WHEREAS, In addition to the direct damage to crops and forage, noxious weeds adversely affect rural and urban land values, tax revenues, recreational opportunities and wildlife habitat; and
- WHEREAS, Weeds declared noxious shall be confined to weeds that are difficult to control, easily spread, and injurious to public health, crops, livestock, land, and other property; and

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, The Tribal Business Council does declare that the following weeds have been declared Noxious:

- 1. Absinth wormwood (Artemisia absinthium L.)
- 2. Canada thistle (Cirsium arvense (L.) Scop.)
- 3. Diffuse knapweed (Centaurea diffusa Lam.)
- 4. Field bindweed (Convolvulus arvensis L.)
- 5. Leafy spurge (Euphorbia esula L.)
- 6. Musk thistle (Carduus nutans L.)
- 7. Purple loosestrife (Lythrum salicaria L., Lythrum vigatum L., and all cultivars)
- 8. Russian knapweed (Centaurea repens L.)
- 9. Spotted knapweed (Centaurea maculosa Lamp.)
- 10. Yellow starthistle (Centaurea solstitialis L.)
