WHEREAS,	This Nation having accepted the Indian Reorganization Act of June 18, 1934, and the authority under said Act; and			
WHEREAS,	The Constitution of the Three Affiliated Tribes generally authorizes and empowers the Tribal Business Council to engage in activities on behalf of and in the interest of the welfare and benefit of the Tribes and of the enrolled members thereof; and			
WHEREAS,	Article VI, Section 5(c), of the Tribal Constitution provides that the Tribal Business Council may administer any funds or property within the exclusive control of the Tribes to make expenditures from available Tribal funds; and			
WHEREAS,	Pursuant to Resolution #97-158-EH, the Three Affiliated Tribes Tribal Business Council authorized the filing of the Indian Community Development Block Grant application which included funding for construction of the Parshall Health Center; and			
WHEREAS,	The construction of the Parshall Health Center is now complete and includes a medical clinic, senior citizen center, the Woman, Infant, and Children program, and the Community Health Representative office as well as an exercise center and office space to accommodate other social welfare services; and			
WHEREAS,	The Three Affiliated Tribes Tribal Business Council recognizes that in order to provide the Parshall/Lucky Mound residents with the necessary programs contained within the Parshall Health Center, certain specialized equipment and fixtures must be identified and purchased; and			
WHEREAS,	There is a need of such additional necessary related costs to complete the project;			
NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, That the Three Affiliated Tribes Tribal Business Council hereby authorizes and appropriates the amount of \$ 35,000 to purchase such equipment and fixtures as may be identified and suitable for the purpose of furnishing the Parshall Health Center, such materials to be identified and cataloged as Three Affiliated Tribes tribal equipment.
