# RESOLUTION OF THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE THREE AFFILIATED TRIBES OF THE FORT BERTHOLD RESERVATION 

WHEREAS, This Nation having accepted the Indian Reorganization Act of June 18,
1934 and the Authority under said Act; and
WHEREAS, The Constitution of the Three Affiliated Tribes generally authorizes and empowers the Tribal Business Council to engage in activities on behalf of and in the interest of the welfare and benefit or the Tribes and of the enrolled members thereof; and

WHEREAS, Article VI, Section 5 (c) of the Constitution of the Three Affiliated Tribes specifically authorizes and empowers the Tribal Business Council to administer funds within the exclusive control of the Tribes and to make expenditures from available Tribal funds for public purposes of the Tribes;

WHEREAS, Three Affiliated Tribes Chairman Tex Hall has been asked by different tribes to run for president of the National Congress of American Indians, which is the oldest and largest organization of Indian Nations in the United States, founded in 1944 and representing more than 220 sovereign Indian Nations; and

WHEREAS, The Tribal Business Council has passed a resolution endorsing Chairman Hall's candidacy for president of the National Congress of American Indians for the years 2001-2003; and

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, That the Tribal Business Council hereby approves the amount of $\$ 1,500$ to assist Chairman Hall's candidacy for president of National Congress of American Indians and for expenses relating to the campaign which includes meeting rooms and travel related to National Congress of American Indians and to any other expenses that may be incurred for this bid for president of National Congress of American Indians; any dollars not used will be applied to future travel expenses of NCAI.
