

**RESOLUTION OF THE GOVERNING BODY OF
THE THREE AFFILIATED TRIBES OF THE
FORT BERTHOLD RESERVATION**

- WHEREAS,** This Nation having accepted the Indian Reorganization Act of June 18, 1934, and the authority under said Act; and
- WHEREAS,** The Constitution of the Three Affiliated Tribes generally authorizes and empowers the Tribal Business Council to engage in activities on behalf of and in the interest of the welfare and benefit of the Tribes and of the enrolled members thereof; and
- WHEREAS,** The Tribal Business Council has previously chartered Fort Berthold Development Corporation (FBDC) as a fully Tribally owned corporation whose primary business is building construction and modification, primarily on the Fort Berthold Reservation; and
- WHEREAS,** FBDC has obtained approval of a loan with Dakota West Credit Union for the purchase of three items of construction equipment which FBDC has been renting for the past year, and which will give credit against the purchase price to FBDC for approximately 75% of the rental cost of the equipment to date; and
- WHEREAS,** The terms of the loan with Dakota West Credit Union are on the attached Term Sheet dated October 25, 2001, and require that the Tribe provide a limited waiver of sovereign immunity and an unconditional guarantee of the loan; and
- WHEREAS,** The Tribe understands that the limited waiver of sovereign immunity will be both: 1) a waiver of any objection the Tribe might raise against the seizure by the Credit Union of the equipment that is the collateral on the loan, provided the Credit Union utilizes the Tribe's repossession statutes and 2) a limited waiver up to the amount owing on the loan after sale of the equipment that is collateral on the loan; and
- WHEREAS,** The term "unconditional guarantee" means that the Tribe agrees to pay any amount owing on the loan at the time the Credit Union Exercises any right it has to collect on the loan for non-payment, less any amount received from sale of the equipment that is the collateral for the loan; and
- WHEREAS,** The total amount of the loan is \$234,489.00, which includes the total remaining owing on the pieces of equipment after credit has been given for previous rental payments to the vendor of the equipment, Krider Equipment Co., Inc. to be paid back in 48 equal installments at an interest rate of 8.9%, with monthly payments of approximately \$5,800; and

WHEREAS, The equipment being financed is described in the term sheets, and is generally a 1998 Case 9050B excavator, worth approximately \$231,000; a 2000 Case 688G-II fork lift, worth approximately \$81,000, and a 1998 Bomag BW-851 compactor worth approximately \$26,000; and

WHEREAS, FBDC has demonstrated to the Tribal Business Council sufficient financial resources to enable the Council to determine that repayment of the loan for the purchase of this equipment is assured and that there is little likelihood that the Tribe's unconditional guarantee of the loan will ever be enforced against the Tribe; and

WHEREAS, The proposed loan, the unconditional guarantee and the limited waiver of sovereign immunity with respect to the collateral equipment are determined to be in the best interests of the Three Affiliated Tribes and its members;

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the Tribal Business Council hereby approves the loan between Fort Berthold Development Corporation (FBDC) and Dakota West Credit Union for the purchase of the three items of heavy construction equipment mentioned above, on the terms as stated in the attached term sheet; and

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Tribal Business Council hereby approves, subject to review and approval by the Tribal legal department, the unconditional loan guarantee and a limited waiver of sovereign immunity of the Tribe, with the understanding that the limited waiver of sovereign immunity will be both: 1) a waiver of any objection the Tribe might raise against the seizure by the Credit Union of the equipment that is the collateral on the loan, provided the Credit Union utilizes the Tribe's repossession statutes; and 2) a limited waiver up to the amount owing on the loan after sale of the equipment that is collateral on the loan and with the understanding that the unconditional guarantee is limited to the amount owing to Dakota Credit Union following repossession and sale of the equipment that is collateral for the loan; and

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Tribal Business Council hereby authorizes the Chairman or the Vice-Chairman to execute such documents as may be necessary to complete the transaction represented by the attached term sheet, subject to review and approval by the Tribal legal department; and

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED, that Resolution No. 01-285-MWJR is hereby rescinded in its entirety.



Dear Mr. Zubke:


The following should be used as the limited waiver of sovereign immunity language for the Tribe:

Limited Waiver of Sovereign Immunity: The Tribe agrees that it shall waive its sovereign immunity for the sole and limited purpose of providing an unconditional guarantee for the Loan to FBDC that is the object of this transaction, with such waiver of sovereign immunity being further limited to: 1) a waiver of any objection the Tribe might raise against the seizure by the Credit Union of the equipment that is the collateral on the loan, provided the Credit Union utilizes the Tribe's repossession statutes; and 2) a limited waiver of sovereign immunity up to the amount still owing on the loan at the time of any default on the Loan which makes the use of this waiver necessary, and only up to that amount that is still owing to the Credit Union that after sale of the equipment that is collateral on the loan.
