

RESOLUTION OF THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE THREE AFFILIATED TRIBES OF THE FORT BERTHOLD INDIAN RESERVATION

- **WHEREAS,** This Nation having accepted the Indian Reorganization Act of June 18, 1934 and the Authority under said Act; and
- **WHEREAS**, The Constitution of the Three Affiliated Tribes generally authorizes and empowers the Tribal Business Council to engage in activities on behalf of and in the interest of the welfare and benefit or the Tribes and of the enrolled members thereof; and
- **WHEREAS,** Article VI, Section 5 (c) of the Constitution provides that the Tribal Business Council shall have the power to administer Tribal funds or property within the exclusive control of the tribes; and
- **WHEREAS**, The Business Council of the Three Affiliated Tribes recognizes the need to support and promote the academic and extracurricular activity programs of our youth; and
- WHEREAS, Ruth Anna Buffalo, an enrolled member of the Mandan, Hidatsa and Arikara Nation and a student at Huron University has been invited to attend and participate in the Women's Pro Basketball Showcase at the Campus of Life University in Atlanta Georgia on June 1 and 2, 2002; and
- **WHEREAS,** The Woman's Pro Basketball Showcase is hosted by Contract sports, an internationally recognized sports agency; and
- WHEREAS, Ruth Anna Buffalo has requested assistance in the amount of \$1,573 to attend this prestigious event where she will compete against some of the most talented ballplayers in the United States and where she will be exposed to professional scouts from across the nation; and
- **NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED,** that the Tribal Business Council, hereby authorizes and approves \$1,150 for Ruth Anna Buffalo to attend the Women's Pro Basketball Showcase at the Campus of Life University in Atlanta, Georgia on June 1-2, 2002
