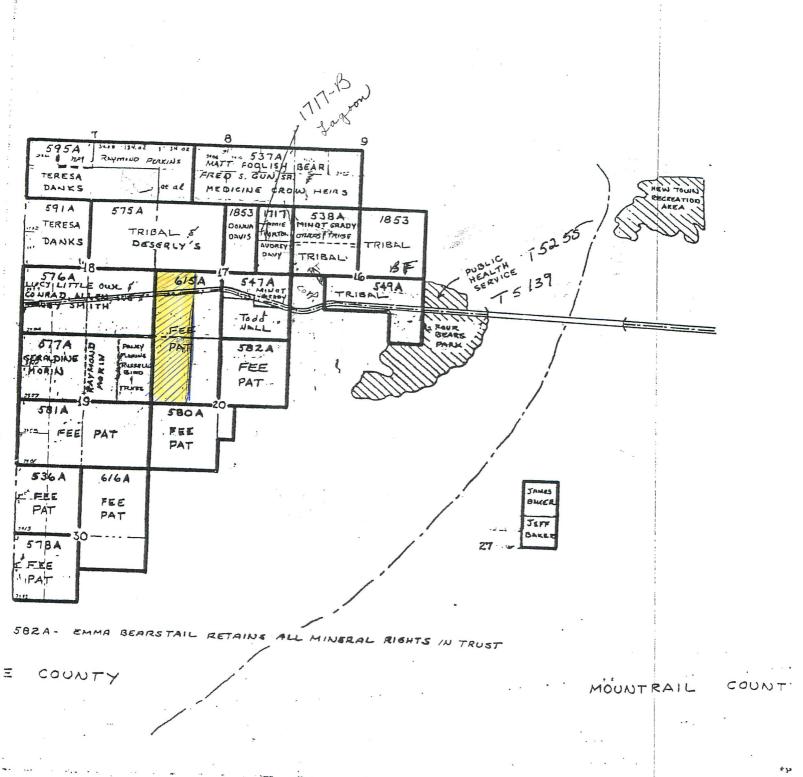
A Resolution entitled, "Approval of Land Purchase from Tribal Member Mabel Snow Bird a/k/a Mabel Elk; U-3063"

- **WHEREAS,** This Nation having accepted the Indian Reorganization Act of June 18, 1934, and the authority under said Act; and
- WHEREAS, The Three Affiliated Tribes Constitution authorizes and empowers the Mandan, Hidatsa & Arikara Tribal Business Council to engage in activity on behalf of and in the interest of the welfare and benefit of the Tribes and of the enrolled members thereof; and
- **WHEREAS,** The Natural Resources Committee had previously approved a land exchange and land purchase regarding Mabel Snow Bird in calendar year 1999; and
- WHEREAS, It has been determined that it is in the best interest of the Tribes to acquire 100 acres, more or less, of fee simple land from Mabel Snow Bird for the construction of a new Four Bears Lagoon System to serve Dragswolf Village, Bakersfield Subdivision, Minni-Tohe Health Center and housing units, Dialysis Center, the Tribal Administration Building and the Four Bears Casino and Lodge.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, the Three Affiliated Tribes Tribal Business Council approves the purchase of land, exclusive of minerals, from

MABEL SNOW BIRD a/k/a MABEL ELK; U-3063

for a cash consideration of One Thousand Dollars (\$1,000) per acre, which is above Fair Market Value, utilizing funds from the JTAC Line Item for Land Purchases and hereby authorizes the Chairman of the Tribal Business Council and it's Secretary to do all things necessary to transfer the title of the lands to the Three Affiliated Tribes of the Fort Berthold Indian Reservation, to wit:

- WHEREAS, The Natural Resources Committee had previously approved a land exchange and land purchase regarding Mabel Snow Bird in calendar year 1999; and
- WHEREAS, It has been determined that it is in the best interest of the Tribes to acquire 130 acres, more or less, of fee simple land from Mabel Snow Bird for the construction of a new Four Bears Lagoon System to serve Drags Wolf Village, Bakersfield Subdivision, Mini-Tohe Health Center and housing units, Dialysis Center, the Tribal Administration Building and the Four Bears Casino and Lodge.
