

RESOLUTION OF THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE THREE AFFILIATED TRIBES OF THE FORT BERTHOLD INDIAN RESERVATION

- A Resolution entitled, "Request for US Corps of Engineers Assistance in planning parks and recreation areas along the shoreline of Lake Sakakawea on the Fort Berthold Reservation"
- **WHEREAS,** This Nation having accepted the Indian Reorganization Act of June 18, 1934, and the authority under said Act; and
- WHEREAS, The Three Affiliated Tribes Constitution authorizes and empowers the Mandan, Hidatsa & Arikara Tribal Business Council to engage in activity on behalf of and in the interest of the welfare and benefit of the Tribes and of the enrolled members thereof; and
- WHEREAS, The Mandan, Hidatsa, and Arikara tribes, prior to the construction of the Garrison Dam, were self-sufficient and used the many resources of the rich bottom lands along the Missouri River; and
- **WHEREAS,** The U.S. Army Corps of Engineers constructed the Garrison Dam and its reservoir flooded 155,000 acres of prime river bottom land and created a social and economic disruption in the lifestyles of the Mandan, Hidatsa, and Arikara tribes; and
- WHEREAS, The Mandan, Hidatsa, and Arikara's purpose to recover their economy by developing parks and recreation areas along the 600 miles of shoreline of Lake Sakakawea within the boundaries of the Fort Berthold Indian Reservation; and
- **WHEREAS**, The Three Affiliated Tribes have designated parks and recreation areas along the shoreline of Lake Sakakawea to accommodate the anticipated influx of tourists and visitors to the reservation during the Lewis and Clark Bi-Centennial; and
- **WHEREAS**, The Three Affiliated Tribes need management plans for the above parks to assure a safe drinking water supply, water recreation and navigation, and environmental studies; and
- **WHEREAS**, The Corps of Engineers have certain programs for planning and technical assistance to Indian tribes in water and related land resource management; and
- NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the Tribal Business needs technical assistance with the planning, design and management systems for the parks along the shoreline of Lake Sakakawea within the boundaries of the Fort Berthold Indian Reservation; and



FINALLY, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Three Affiliated Tribal Business Council requests the Corps of Engineers to provide assistance in planning the development of said parks with whatever programs the Corps has available for such purposes.
