A Resolution entitled, "Request for Bureau of Indian Affairs Facility Engineering Office to assist in planning and design of Public Works Facility"

- **WHEREAS,** This Nation having accepted the Indian Reorganization Act of June 18, 1934, and the authority under said Act; and
- WHEREAS, The Three Affiliated Tribes Constitution authorizes and empowers the Mandan, Hidatsa & Arikara Tribal Business Council to engage in activity on behalf of and in the interest of the welfare and benefit of the Tribes and of the enrolled members thereof: and
- **WHEREAS,** The Three Affiliated Tribes Public Works Department is in need of a shop for overhaul and repair of heavy equipment and warehouse for facilities management; and
- **WHEREAS,** The Three Affiliated Tribes are in need of a new office building capable of accommodating all Tribal and Federal programs operating on the Fort Berthold Reservation; and
- WHEREAS, The Bureau of Indian Affairs Facilities Engineering Program located in Albuquerque, New Mexico, has designed similar facilities for other reservations and have the capabilities to assist the Three Affiliated Tribes to plan and design these needed facilities; and
- **NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED,** that the Tribal Business Council hereby requests the Bureau of Indian Affairs Facility Engineering Office in Albuquerque, New Mexico, to visit our reservation and assist in the planning and design of facilities to serve our Public Works Program and offices for tribal and federal programs.
