

RESOLUTION OF THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE THREE AFFILIATED TRIBES OF THE FORT BERTHOLD RESERVATION

WHEREAS,

This Nation having accepted the Indian Reorganization Act of June 18, 1934, and the authority under said Act; and

WHEREAS,

The Constitution of the Three Affiliated Tribes generally Authorizes and empowers the Tribal Business Council to engage in activities on behalf of and in the interest of the welfare and benefit of the Tribes and enrolled members thereof; and

WHEREAS,

Article VI, Section 3 of the Constitution of the Three Affiliated Tribes specifically authorizes and empowers the Tribal Business Council to delegate to the Fort Berthold District Court such judicial power and authority as may be necessary to realize the jurisdiction granted by the people of the Tribes in Article I of the Constitution; and

WHEREAS,

Title I, Chapter 1, Section 4.3 of the Fort Berthold Tribal Code authorizes and mandates that the Tribal Business Council appoint a member of the Three Affiliated Tribes to serve as District Judge of the Fort Berthold District Court for a term of two years (2); and

WHEREAS,

El Marie Conklin currently serves as District Judge of the District Court and has so served continuously since October 05, 2001; and

WHEREAS,

The current two (2)-year term of District Judge Conklin is due to expire on September 28, 2003 and Judge Conklin has expressed her desire for reappointment to the position of District Judge for a successive two (2)-year term; and

WHEREAS,

It is the considered judgment of the Tribal Business Council that it would be in the best interest of the Three Affiliated Tribes to reappoint El Marie Conklin to serve as District Judge of the District Court for a successive term of two (2) years;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, That the Tribal Business Council of the Three Affiliated Tribes, pursuant to Title I, Chapter 1, Section 4.3 of the Fort Berthold Tribal Code, hereby formally appoints El Marie Conklin as

Three Affiliated Tribes Tribal Business Council Regular Meeting No. 03-17-RP

23. THE FORECLOSURE CODE; RESOLUTION NO. 03-240-RP:

Councilman Gillette moved for approval of Resolution No. 03-240-RP, with the amended language in Clause No. ____ "hereby designates the attorney for the Three Affiliated Tribes to initiate and supervise the sale of said property." Councilman Packineau seconded the motion.

VOTE:

6 Ayes, 0 Nays, 0 Abstentions, 0 Not voting. Motion carried.

2 AREADRO NEWENT OF DISTRICES UDGE EL-MARIE CONKEIN; 3 ARESOLUTION NO 208-241-RP; 3

Councilman Wolf moved for approval to renew the District Judge contract for a two-year term, subject to a yearly evaluation, and upon a satisfactory performance the remainder of the contract would be continuous. Councilman Gillette seconded the motion.

WOTE 4 Ayes, 2 Navs, 0 Abstentions, 0 Not voting. Motion carried.

25. COMPENSATION FOR DISTRICT JUDGE:

Councilman Wells moved to approve a salary increase for the Chief Judge at \$62,000. Motion failed due to lack of a second.

Councilman Wolf moved for approval of a salary increase to \$62,000. Councilman Wells seconded the motion.

Councilman Wolf amended his motion to increase District Judge's salary to \$65,000 without retroactive pay. Councilman Wells concurred with the amendment.

VOTE: 4 Ayes, 1 Nay, 1 Abstentions, 0 Not voting. Motion carried.

26. FORT BERTHOLD COMMUNITY COLLEGE; RESOLUTION NO. 03-242-RP

Councilman Wells moved for approval of a resolution that allows the Tribe to guarantee a loan for the Fort Berthold Community College in the amount of \$700,000 with the Lakeside State Bank and Bank of North Dakota, the total amount will be due on April 01, 2003; and to provide a monthly review of the statement of the general fund. Councilman Phelan seconded the motion.

Councilman Wells amended to increase the loan to \$750,000. Councilman Phelan concurred with the amendment.

VOTE:

5 Ayes, 0 Nays, 0 Abstentions, 0 Not voting. Motion carried.

SPECIAL PROJECTS CONSULTANT AGREEMENT:

Councilman Phelan moved for approval of a Special Projects consultant agreement with Dawn Charging for a period of six (6) months effective as of this date to the end of the fiscal year not to exceed \$10,500. Councilman Packineau seconded the motion.

DISCUSSION: Ms. Charging, in coordination with Ted Lone Fight, III, will provide marketing assistance for various tribal projects, initially, assistance in the procurement of USDA contracts for the Buffalo Project. Councilman Phelan recommended ITBC and Tatanka, Inc. as possible marketing grant funding sources. Chairman Hall recommended that Ms. Charging prioritize the Buffalo Project application for 8(a) status to guarantee federal contracts.

VOTE:

7 Ayes, 0 Nays, 0 Abstentions, 0 Not voting. Motion carried.

COURT EVALUATORS:

Councilman Packineau moved for approval of consultant agreements, subject to legal review, with Kayland Free and Alisa LaCount not to exceed \$20,000 for assistance in conducting the Tribal Court evaluation, subject to the availability of funds and concurrence from the Criminal Investigator.

DISCUSSION: Councilman Packineau and Councilman Wells concurred to amend the motion to ensure that the consultant agreements are subject to legal review.

VOTE:

7 Ayes, 0 Nays, 0 Abstentions, 0 Not voting. Motion carried.

CONSULTANT AGREEMENT:

Councilman Wolf moved for approval of a settlement in the amount of \$7,000 with Mr. Al Nygaard, as negotiated by Councilman Wolf and Richard Mayer, C.E.O., and also, to direct TAT Legal to draft a settlement agreement that would include the following: 1) a release for the Tribe from all potential claims and/or lawsuits by Al Nygaard; 2) that Mr. Al Nygaard provide all reports and disclosure of information concerning the Detention Center project; and 3) to release the Tribe from all other contracts that Mr. Nygaard may have entered into, either verbally or in writing, that have not been disclosed to the Tribe. Councilman Packineau seconded the motion.

VOTE:

4 Ayes, 1 Nay, 0 Abstentions, 0 Not voting. Motion carried.

DISCUSSION: Councilman Wolf and Tom Disselhorst will provide follow-up on this issue. No payment will be issued until Tom Disselhorst and Councilman Wolf have finalized the settlement agreement.

The following personnel actions were approved during **closed session** at the Continuation of the Regular March 13, 2003 meeting held on April 1, 2003:

CIRCLE OF LIFE:

Councilman Wells moved for approval of a rate increase for Cheryl Fox, 570 Program Coordinator/Licensed Addiction Counselor, from \$14.36 to \$17.00. Councilman Wolf seconded the motion.

VOTE:

6 Ayes, 0 Nays, 0 Abstentions, 0 Not voting. Motion carried.

LESTER CROWS HEART:

Councilman Wells moved for approval to direct Richard Mayer, C.E.O.; Hugh Baker, Federal Programs Manager; and Barlow Wells, HR Director to review Mr. Lester Crows Heart's situation. Councilman Spotted Bear seconded the motion.

SALARIES OF NORTH DAKOTA TRIBAL JUDGES

Sisseton Wahpeton Sioux Tribe pays their judge \$500.00 day x 3 days a week for a total of \$78,000.00 per year.

Standing Rock Sioux Tribe pays their Chief Judge \$50.00 dollars an hour for a total of \$104,000.00. The Associate Judge (law degree, no bar license) \$35.00 an hour for a yearly salary of \$72,800.00.

The Spirit Lake Sioux Tribe pays their Chief Judge \$65.00 an hour at 32 hours a week with no fringe under contract for \$108,160.00 for fifty two weeks.

Turtle Mountain pays their chief judge \$70,000.00 each year during their fouryear term. The Chief Judge does not have to be a lawyer.

Three Affiliated Tribes currently pays their chief judge \$54, 995.20. (which breaks down to an hourly rate of \$26.44)

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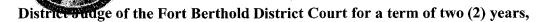
