# RESOLUTION OF THEGOVERNING BODY OF THE THREE AFFILIATED TRIBES OF THE FORT BERTHOLD INDIAN RESERVATION

A Resolution entitled "Gift Conveyance by Eleanor Sorenson to the Three Affiliated Tribes"

- WHEREAS, This Nation having accepted the Indian Reorganization Act of June 18, 1934, and the authority under said Act; and
- WHEREAS, The Constitution of the Three Affiliated Tribes generally authorizes and empowers the Tribal Business Council to engage in activities on behalf of and in the interest of the welfare and benefit of the Tribes and of the enrolled members thereof, and
- WHEREAS, The Natural Resources Committee of the Tribal Business Council recommends the acceptance of the gift conveyance of property described below; and
- WHEREAS, It has been determined that it is in the best interest of the Tribe to accept the land; and
- NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, The Three Affiliated Tribes' Tribal Business Council accepts the gift conveyance of land, exclusive of minerals, from:

The conveyance to the Three Affiliated Tribes is described in a metes and bounds description as follows:

Commencing at the south quarter section of Section 13, thence N48<sup>0</sup>08'17"E, a distance of 1753.49 feet to the northerly right-of-way line of Highway #23 and the Point of Beginning; thence N23<sup>0</sup>16'41"W, a distance of 50.00 feet; thence N66<sup>0</sup>43'19"E, a distance of 100.00 feet; thence S23<sup>0</sup>16'41"E, a distance of 50.00 feet to said northerly right-of-way line of Highway #23; thence S66<sup>0</sup>43'19"W along said northerly right-of-way line of Highway #23, a distance of 100.00 feet to the Point of Beginning, said Point of Beginning being located N48<sup>0</sup>56'27"W, a distance of 1781.52 feet from the southeast section corner of Section 13, T. 152 N., R. 94 W., Fifth Principal Meridian, North Dakota, containing 0.11 acres, more or less.

Subject to a prior reservation of oil, gas, sand, gravel and other minerals as recorded. Subject to all valid existing rights-of-way of record.

in hand paid, the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, do. es hereby grant, bargain, sell, and convey
unto said partY of the second part the following-described real estate and premises situated in  McKenzie County, State of North Dakota
Fort Berthold Reservation Indian Reservation, to wit: Commencing at the south quarter section corner of Section 13, thence N48°08'17"E, a distance of 753.49 feet to the northerly right-of-way line of Highway #23 and the Point of Beginning; thence N23°16'41"W, a distance of 50.00 feet; thence N66°43'19"E, a distance of 100.00 feet; thence S23°16"41"E, a distance of 50.00 feet to said northerly right-of-way line of Highway #23; thence S66°43'19"W along said northerly right-of-way of line of Highway #23, a distance of 100.00 feet to the Point of Beginning, said Point of Beginning being located N48°56'27"W, a distance of 1781.52 feet from the southeast section corner of Section 13, T. 152 N., R. 94 W., Fifth Principal Meridian, North Dakota, containing 0.11 acres, more or less. Subject to a prior reservation of oil, gas, sand, gravel and other minerals as recorded. Subject to all valid existing rights-of-way of record. BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, The Three Affiliated Tribal Business Council acknowledges the generosity of tribal elder, Eleanor Hale Sorenson, of the gift conveyance as described above for the use of a lift station for the Fort Berthold Rural Water Department; and

BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED, The Three Affiliated Tribes Rural Water Department will construct a water line and provide free water for domestic and livestock use to that portion of Allotment No. 593A which lies south of State Highway #23 to Eleanor Hale Sorenson and her heirs.
