

RESOLUTION OF THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE THREE AFFILIATED TRIBES OF THE FORT BERTHOLD INDIAN RESERVATION

A Resolution entitled "Approval of Buffalo Robe Purchase from Ron Brugh."

- WHEREAS, This Nation having accepted the Indian Reorganization Act of June 18, 1934, and the authority under said Act; and
- WHEREAS, The Three Affiliated Tribes Constitution and Bylaws authorizes and empowers the Mandan, Hidatsa and Arikara Tribal Business Council to engage in activity on behalf of and in the best interest and welfare of the Tribes and the enrolled members thereof; and
- WHEREAS, the Tribal Business Council has specifically authorized to administer any funds or property within the exclusive control of the tribes and to make expenditures of available tribal funds for public purposes of the tribes; and
- WHEREAS, Tribal member Ron Brugh has offered to sell a painted mature buffalo robe to the tribe for \$4,500.00 and
- WHEREAS, the Tribal Business Council desires to purchase said robe.
- NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the Tribal Business Council hereby approves of the purchase of one painted, mature buffalo robe for the price of \$4,500.00 from Ron Brugh.
