

OF THE THREE AFFILIATED TRIBES OF THE FORT BERTHOLD INDIAN RESERVATION

A Resolution entitled "Authorization For Tribal Participation in the Supreme Court Case of U.S. v. Lara."

- WHEREAS, This Nation having accepted the Indian Reorganization Act of June 18, 1934, and the authority under said Act; and
- WHEREAS, The Three Affiliated Tribes Constitution and Bylaws authorizes and empowers the Three Affiliated Tribes' Tribal Business Council to engage in activity on behalf of and in the best interest and welfare of the Tribes and the enrolled members thereof; and
- WHEREAS, There is presently pending before the United States Supreme Court a case entitled United States v. Lara which involves the question of a Tribe's ability to prosecute non-member Indians for crimes committed on Indian Reservations; and
- WHEREAS, This outcome of the Surpeme Court's decision is critical to Indian tribe; and
- WHEREAS, The Three Affiliated Tribes has been invited to participate in this case as by submitting an *amicus curiae* (friend of the court) brief; and
- WHEREAS, The Three Affiliated Tribes has also been asked to provide some statistical information concerning the Fort Berthold Reservation relevant to this case; and
- **WHEREAS**, The Tribal Business Council desires to participate in this case to the greatest extent possible and contribute financially towards the submission of an *amicus curiae* brief.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, That the Tribal Business Council hereby authorizes the law firm of Hobbs, Straus, Dean & Walker, LLP to name the Tribe as a participating the Tribe in the submission of an *amicus curiae* brief and further authorizes a contribution in the amount of \$10,000 towards the submission of such a brief.

BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED, that Prosecutor Bill Woods is directed to work closely with the Native American Rights Fund and provide statistical information pertinent to the <u>U.S. v. Lara</u> Case.
