RESOULUTION OF THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE THREE AFFILIATED TRIBES OF THE FORT BERTHOLD RESERVATION

Titled: Noxious Weed Priority Eradication Ranking

- WHEREAS, This Nation having accepted the Indian Reorganization Act of June 18, 1934 and the authority under said act; and
- WHEREAS, The Constitution of the Three affiliated Tribes generally authorizes and empowers the Tribal Business Council to engage in activities on behalf
- WHEREAS, Article VI Section 5 (j) empowers the Tribes to protect and preserve the natural resources of the Fort Berthold Reservation; and
- WHEREAS, The Tribal Business Council desires to increase revenue derived from tribal range unit lands by eradication of noxious plants and prevent the spread of those plants to other range lands on the reservation; and
- WHEREAS, The Tribal Business Council through the Natural Resources Committee had directed the Natural Resources Department to take necessary measures to ensure that every effort is taken to eradicate noxious plants on the reservation; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Tribal Business Council of the Three Affiliated Tribes herby declares and prioritizes the following noxious plants in order for eradication: 1. Leafy Spurge (euphorbia esula), 2. Purple Loosestrife (lytrhum salicaria), 3. Canada Thistle (cirsium arvense) 4. Musk Thistle (carduus natans), 5. Russian knapweed (centaurea repens), 6. Spotted Knapweed (centaurea maculosa) 7. Tropical Soda Apple (solanum viarum), 8. Yellow Star Thistle (centaurea solstitalis), 9. Congongrass (imperata cylindrical) 10. Salt Cedar (tamarix ramosissima). on the reservation.
