

OF THE THREE AFFILIATED TRIBES OF THE FORT BERTHOLD INDIAN RESERVATION

A Resolution entitled, "Authorization for Tribal Housing Division to Purchase Lots from Fritz Bird Bear.

- WHEREAS, This Nation having accepted the Indian Reorganization Act of June 18, 1934, and the authority under said Act; and
- WHEREAS, The Three Affiliated Tribes' Constitution authorizes and empowers the Mandan, Hidatsa & Arikara Tribal Business Council to engage in activity on behalf of and in the interest of the welfare and benefit of the Tribes and of the enrolled members thereof; and
- WHEREAS, Article VI, Section 5(c) of the Constitution of the Three Affiliated Tribes specifically authorizes and empowers the Tribal Business Council to administer funds within the exclusive control of the Tribes and to make expenditures from available Tribal funds for public purposes of the Tribes; and
- WHEREAS, There exists within the several segments of the Fort Berthold Reservation an unmet need for adequate individual family housing including single family units and multifamily dwellings; and
- WHEREAS, In order to develop housing to fill the needs of the enrolled members of the Three Tribes, the Tribal Business Council created the Tribal Housing Division; and
- WHEREAS, The Tribal Housing Division administers several programs in order to fulfill its mandate. The Dreamcatcher Program is one of the programs administered by the Housing Division. The Tribal Housing Division administers an Elder Housing Program, Military Housing Program and the Housing Improvement Program. The Housing Division also participates in the Fort Berthold Housing Authority five-year plan. The Housing Division has provided for the finance and purchase of manufactured homes and mobile homes and in assisting members in refinancing their existing home mortgages. The Housing Division completes its mandate with several educated, experienced and qualified staff members all who are knowledgeable of the housing needs of the people they serve; and
- WHEREAS, The Tribal Housing Division, because of limited availability of city and town lots, has been forced into a competitive market for the acquisition of city and town lots; and taking into consideration the number of housing programs administered by the Housing Division of the Three Affiliated Tribes, the number of people it serves and the competent staff employed by the Housing Division, it serves the best interest of the members of the Three Affiliated Tribes to allow the Housing Division to acquire lots for continued housing development; and

Per your request I have inspected the above property and in my opinion the present fair market value of the lots are \$4,000 each or \$8,000 for the 2 lots.

These lots are adjacent to the Dream Catcher project of the Three Affiliated Tribes and the street running north and south. On the west side of Lot 19 is one of the main entrances to the Dream Catcher Project.

The lots are level and would be good to build on, but they need to be cleaned up. There have been several vehicles abandoned on the property, my inspection did not indicate any environmental hazards or dumping of contaminates but as they are cleaned up it should be inspected.
