
A Resolution entitled, "Gift of Land by Eleanor Sorenson aka Mary Eleanor Hale, U-000417, a Married Woman"

- WHEREAS, This Nation having accepted the Indian Reorganization Act of June 18, 1934 and the authority under said Act; and
- WHEREAS, The Constitution of the Three Affiliated Tribes authorizes and empowers the Mandan, Hidatsa & Arikara Tribal Business Council to engage in activities on behalf of and in the interest of the welfare and benefit of the Tribes and of the enrolled members thereof; and
- WHEREAS, The Natural Resources Committee of the Tribal Business Council approved the acceptance of a gift of .14 acres to the Three Affiliated Tribes from Eleanor Sorenson, under the terms and conditions stated below; and
- NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, That the Three Affiliated Tribes' Tribal Business Council approves the gift of .14 acre of land within the SE1/4 of Section 13, Township 152 North, Range 94 West, Fifth Principal Meridian, McKenzie County, North Dakota, as described in the attached certified survey prepared by Bartlett & West, exclusive of minerals, held in trust by the United States of America for the Three Affiliated Tribes, and hereby authorizes the Chairman of the Tribal Business Council. its Secretary, and the Superintendent of the Fort Berthold Agency, the Area Director, and the Commissioner of Indian Affairs to prepare all documents and to do all things necessary to transfer title to the Tribe from Eleanor Sorenson, under the terms and conditions as stated below:

That water be provided to the south side of North Dakota State Highway #23 for domestic use, home and livestock, for her and her heirs.
