

RESOLUTION OF THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE THREE AFFILIATED TRIBES OF THE FORT BERTHOLD INDIAN RESERVATION

A Resolution entitled, "Amendment to the Charter of the Fort Berthold Community College Prohibiting the Expenditure or Obligation of the Principal Amount of any Endowment Funds."

- WHEREAS, This Nation having accepted the Indian Reorganization Act of June 18, 1934, and the authority under said Act and having adopted and Constitution and By-laws pursuant to said Act; and
- **WHEREAS,** Article III of the Constitution of the Three Affiliated Tribes provides that the Tribal Business Council is the governing body of the Tribe; and
- WHEREAS, The Constitution of the Three Affiliated Tribes authorizes and empowers the Tribal Business Council to engage in activities on behalf of and in the interest of the welfare and benefit of the Tribes and of the enrolled members thereof; and
- WHEREAS, Article VI, Section 5 (1) of the Constitution of the Three Affiliated Tribes authorizes the Tribal Business Council to adopt resolutions regulating the procedure of tribal agencies and tribal officials on the Reservation; and
- WHEREAS, Article VI, Section 5 (c) authorizes the Tribal Business Council to administer any property or funds within the exclusive control of the Tribes and to make expenditures from available tribal funds for public purposes of the Tribes; and
- WHEREAS, pursuant to Resolution 89-10-77 dated May 11th, 1989, the Tribal Business Council granted a Charter to the non-profit corporation known as the Fort Berthold Community College; and
- WHEREAS, the Fort Berthold Community College from time to time receives certain funds in the form of endowments including grants for the establishment of endowment funds pursuant to the Tribally Controlled Community College Assistance Act; and
- WHEREAS, federal contributions to endowments funds under the Tribally Controlled Community College Assistance Act are restricted by federal law; and
- WHEREAS, the Tribal Business Council finds that the Charter of the Fort Berthold Community College should be amended to add a provisions protecting the principal or corpus of any endowment fund received by the Community College.



NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the Charter of the Fort Berthold Community College is hereby amended by adding the following Section to Article VI:

F. The corpus or principal of any endowment received by the Corporation, including endowments under the Tribally Controlled Community College Assistance Act, shall not be expended, withdrawn, distributed, paid out, obligated or otherwise used by the Corporation.
