

# OF THE THREE AFFILIATED TRIBES OF THE FORT BERTHOLD INDIAN RESERVATION

A Resolution entitled, "Purchase of the New Town Lady Eagles State Basketball Tickets 2005."

- WHEREAS, This Nation having accepted the Indian Reorganization Act of June 18, 1934, and the authority under said Act; and
- WHEREAS, The Three Affiliated Tribes Constitution authorizes and empowers the Mandan, Hidatsa & Arikara Tribal Business Council to engage in activity on behalf of and in the interest of the welfare and benefit of the Tribes and of the enrolled members thereof; and
- WHEREAS, The Tribal Business Council of the Three Affiliated Tribes have previously duly passed resolutions to fund Extracurricular Activities such as appearances at State Basketball Tournaments for Boys and Girls within the State of North Dakota; and
- WHEREAS, The New Town Lady Eagles won the Region 8 Championship on February 24, 2005 and therefore earning a birth to the March 3-5, 2005 Girls State Basketball Tournament; and
- WHEREAS, The New Town School Board of Education and Athletic Director duly requested any financial assistance that maybe available for assistance of Tickets for the supporting fans and students of the New Town School District and other communities within the Fort Berthold Indian Reservation; and

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, That the Tribal Business Council of the Three Affiliated Tribes duly authorizes the purchase of tickets in support of the New Town Lady Eagles the Region 8 Champions for ticket purchases in the amount of \$10,104.00 for 194 adult tickets and 170 student tickets for the 2005 State Basketball Tournament.

#### CERTIFICATION

Councilman White Calf amended his motion to include language, "trading in current vehicle and purchasing a pick-up truck for the Tribal Housing Division."
