

RESOLUTION OF THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE THREE AFFILIATED TRIBES OF THE FORT BERTHOLD INDIAN RESERVATION

A Resolution Entitled: "Adoption of Policy Regarding the Purchase of Trailer/Mobile Homes by the Tribal Housing Division".

- WHEREAS, This Nation having accepted the Indian Reorganization Act of June 18, 1934, and the authority under said Act and having adopted a Constitution and By-laws pursuant to said Act; and
- WHEREAS, Article III of the Constitution of the Three Affiliated Tribes provides that the Tribal Business Council is the governing body of the Tribes; and
- WHEREAS, The Constitution of the Three Affiliated Tribes authorizes and empowers the Tribal Business Council to engage in activities on behalf of and in the interest of the welfare and benefit of the Tribes and of the enrolled members thereof; and
- WHEREAS, Article VI, Section 5 (1) of the Constitution of the Three Affiliated Tribes provides that the Tribal Business Council has the power to adopt resolutions regulating the procedure of the Tribal Business Council and other Tribal agencies and Tribal officials on the Reservation; and
- WHEREAS, Article IX, Section 6 of the Constitution provides that the Tribal Business Council has the power to acquire by purchase, exchange of Tribal lands, relinquishment or otherwise any lands or interests in lands for and on behalf of the Three Affiliated Tribes; and
- WHEREAS, There exists an extreme shortage of housing on the Fort Berthold Reservation and the unmeet housing needs of the Tribe have not been adequately addressed through the United States Department of Housing and Urban Development through the Indian Housing Programs; and
- WHEREAS, To address this unmet housing need for the members of the Three Affiliated Tribes, the Tribal Business Council has established the Tribal Housing Division whose primary purpose is to provide homeownership opportunities for tribal members through the various tribal, federal and state housing development resources available to the Tribes and its members; and
- WHEREAS, There have been a number of tribal members who have offered to sell mobile homes to the Tribes and the Tribal Business Council has accepted these offers and delegated the Tribal Housing Division to be the tribal agency responsible for managing these mobile homes; and
