

# RESOLUTION OF THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE THREE AFFILIATED TRIBES OF THE FORT BERTHOLD INDIAN RESERVATION

# A Resolution entitled, "Authorization for Three Affiliated TribesTribal Housing Division to apply for Federal Home Loan Bank Grant"

- WHEREAS, This Nation having accepted the Indian Reorganization Act of June 18, 1934, and the authority under said Act and having duly adopted a Constitution and By-laws under said act on May 15<sup>th</sup>, 1936; and
- WHEREAS, Article III of the Constitution of the Three Affiliated Tribes provides that the Tribal Business Council is the governing body of the Tribes; and
- WHEREAS, The Three Affiliated Tribes' Constitution authorizes and empowers the Tribal Business Council to engage in activity on behalf of and in the interest of the welfare and benefit of the Tribes and of the enrolled members thereof; and
- WHEREAS, Article VI, Section 5(c) of the Constitution of the Three Affiliated Tribes specifically authorizes and empowers the Tribal Business Council to administer funds within the exclusive control of the Tribes and to make expenditures from available Tribal funds for public purposes of the Tribes; and
- WHEREAS, To address the unmet housing needs for the members of the Three Affiliated Tribes, the Tribal Business Council has established the Tribal Housing Division whose primary purpose is to provide homeownership opportunities for tribal members through the various tribal, federal and state housing development resources available to the Tribes and its members; and
- WHEREAS, The Federal Home Loan Bank provides a competitive grant award to public entities, including Indian Tribes, that provide low income applicants with various housing programs to assist in the attainment of affordable housing; and
- WHEREAS, The Tribal Housing Division has requested authority to apply for the Federal Home Loan Bank Grant in the amount of Two Hundred Fifty Thousand Dollars (\$250,000.00) to provide construction funds for the establishment of twelve (12) Lease-to-Purchase homes for enrolled members that are in need of immediate housing and are willing to work toward becoming eligible homeowners by utilizing the Tribal Housing Division's many services; and
- WHEREAS, The Tribal Business Council finds that it is in the best interests of the Tribes to authorize the Tribal Housing Division to apply for said grant funds from the Federal Home Loan Bank.
