

OF THE THREE AFFILIATED TRIBES OF THE FORT BERTHOLD INDIAN RESERVATION

A Resolution entitled, "Three Affiliated Tribe's Request that the BIA program \$130,000 of FY 2006 Carry-over Funds (or any other available funds) For the MHA Nation Clean Fuels Refinery Project to be Utilized for Phases 4 & 5 of the Refinery Project for FY 2007."

- WHEREAS, This Nation having accepted the Indian Reorganization Act of June 18, 1934, and the authority under said Act; and
- WHEREAS, The Constitution of the Three Affiliated Tribes generally authorizes and empowers the Tribal Business Council to engage in activities on behalf of and in the interest of the welfare and benefit of the Tribes and of the enrolled members thereof; and
- WHEREAS, The Three Affiliated Tribes have been pursuing the MHA Nation Clean Fuels Refinery which will produce 15,000 barrels per stream day and which will be located on the eastern end of the reservation in Ward County, North Dakota near the town of Makoti, North Dakota; and
- WHEREAS, The Three Affiliated Tribes has completed the first three phases of the MHA Nation Clean Fuels Refinery Project which consisted of; site selection, front end engineering and design, data compilation, public scoping meetings, coordination of Federal, State and Tribal government agencies, completion of a draft environmental impact statement study and public hearings; and
- WHEREAS, The MHA Nation Clean Refinery Project is heading into Phases 4 and 5 additional funding to complete this project; and
- WHEREAS, The Three Affiliated Tribes has been notified that there is money available from the Bureau of Indian Affairs through Public Law 477 for the MHA Nation Clean Fuels Refinery Project; and
- WHEREAS The MHA Nation Clean Fuels Refinery Project would be able to retain their Project Manager, Mr. Horace Pipe to complete Phase 4 and 5 of the project; and



WHEREAS, Once Phase 4 and 5 have been completed the Three Affiliated Tribes will then be able to move forward with construction of the refinery and help fulfill one of the goals of the President's energy policy; and

WHEREAS, The Tribal Business Council desires to request additional funding from the BIA in order to fulfill Phases 4 & 5 of the Refinery Project.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Tribal Business Council hereby requests that the BIA program \$130,000 of FY 2006 carry-over funds (or any other available funds) for the MHA Nation Clean Fuels Refinery Project to be utilized for Phases 4 & 5 of the Refinery Project for FY 2007.
