



**RESOLUTION OF THE GOVERNING BODY
OF THE
THREE AFFILIATED TRIBES
OF THE
FORT BERTHOLD INDIAN RESERVATION**

A Resolution Entitled: *“Approval of Land Exchange Between the Three Affiliated Tribes and Dan Hall.”*

WHEREAS, This Nation having accepted the Indian Reorganization Act of June 18, 1934, and the authority under said Act and having adopted a Constitution and By-laws pursuant to said Act; and

WHEREAS, Article III of the Constitution of the Three Affiliated Tribes provides that the Tribal Business Council is the governing body of the Tribes; and

WHEREAS, The Constitution of the Three Affiliated Tribes authorizes and empowers the Tribal Business Council to engage in activities on behalf of and in the interest of the welfare and benefit of the Tribes and of the enrolled members thereof; and

WHEREAS, Article IX, Section 6 of the Constitution of the Three Affiliated Tribes authorizes the Tribal Business Council to acquire by exchange of tribal land any lands or interests in land for and on behalf of the Tribe, subject to the approval of the Secretary of the Interior; and

WHEREAS, Dan Hall, 301-U003509, a member of the Three Affiliated Tribes, has offered to exchange his interests in certain allotments described below for Tribal interests also described below; and

WHEREAS, The Tribal Business Council has determined that the proposed exchange meets the criteria of Article IX, Section 6 of the Constitution of the Three Affiliated Tribes and has further determined that it is in the best interest of the Tribes to acquire all the undivided interests of Dan Hall in the listed allotments in exchange for Tribal interest in Allotment No. T897A; and

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the Tribal Business Council of the Three Affiliated Tribes in accordance with the power vested in it by Article IX, Section 6 of the Constitution of the Three Affiliated Tribes hereby approves a land exchange between Dan Hall and the Three Affiliated Tribes for lands described below:

Dan Hall, 301-U3509

Allot. No. 797A, an undivided 1/12 interest within the S1/2 Sec. 34, T149N., R94W., Fifth Principal Meridian, McKenzie County, containing 320.00 acres, more or less, which his interest is 26.67 acres, valued at \$4,797.00.



Allot. No. 798A, an undivided 1/8 interest within the N1/2 Sec. 27, T149N., R94W., Fifth Principal Meridian, McKenzie County, containing 320.00 acres, more or less, which his interest is 39.99 acres, valued at \$7,857.00.

Allot. No. 800A, an undivided 1/8 interest within the N1/2 Sec. 34, T149N., R94W., Fifth Principal Meridian, McKenzie County, containing 320.00 acres, more or less, which his interest is 39.99 acres, valued at \$7,857.00. Total value is \$20,511.00 for Mr. Hall's land interests. Mr. Hall will waive the difference of \$78.00.

Tribal Land

Allot.No. T897A: for that portion of this Allotment described as Lot 2, NE4NW4 of Section 18, T149N., R94W., Fifth Principal Meridian, Dunn County, containing 79.40 acres, more or less, valued at \$19,453.00.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Tribal Business Council authorizes the Chairman and Secretary to sign all documents necessary to effectuate this exchange; and

BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED, that in accordance with Article IX, Section 6 of the Constitution this transaction shall be subject to the approval of the Secretary of Interior or his authorized representative.

CERTIFICATION

I, the undersigned, as Secretary of the Tribal Business Council of the Three Affiliated Tribes of the Fort Berthold Reservation, hereby certify that the Tribal Business Council is composed of 7 members of whom 5 constitute a quorum, 4 were present at a Regular Meeting thereof duly called, noticed, convened, and held on the 8th day of February 2007; that the foregoing Resolution was duly adopted at such Meeting by the affirmative vote of 4 members, 0 members opposed, 0 members abstained, 0 members not voting, and that said Resolution has not been rescinded or amended in any way.
