- WHEREAS, This Nation having accepted the Indian Reorganization Act of June 18, 1934, and the authority under said Act; and
- WHEREAS, The Constitution of the Three Affiliated Tribes generally authorizes and empowers the Tribal Business Council to engage in activities on behalf of and in the interest of the welfare and benefit of the enrolled members thereof; and
- WHEREAS, The Constitution and By-Laws of the Three Affiliated Tribes empowers the Tribal Business Council to revise the membership rolls and to govern future membership rolls, and
- WHEREAS, Alfred Charles Seaboy requested relinquishment of his/her membership from the Three Affiliated Tribes, Membership has been requested with the Sisseton-Wahpeton Sioux Tribe, and
- WHEREAS, A copy has been received of application confirmation from the Sisseton-Wahpeton Sioux Tribe.
- NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that **Alfred Charles Seaboy** is hereby relinquished from the official membership roll of the Three Affiliated Tribes.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the **Sisseton-Wahpeton Sioux Tribe**, is to be advised with a copy of this resolution.
