

## RESOLUTION OF THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE THREE AFFILIATED TRIBES OF THE FORT BERTHOLD INDIAN RESERVATION

## A Resolution entitled, "CTER/NCCI Native Construction Careers Initiative"

- WHEREAS, This Nation having accepted the Indian Reorganization Act of June 18, 1934, and the authority under said Act and having adopted a Constitution and By-Laws pursuant to said Act; and
- WHEREAS, The Constitution of the Three Affiliated Tribes generally authorizes and empowers the Tribal Business Council to engage in activities on behalf of and in the interest of the welfare and benefit of the Tribes and of the enrolled members thereof; and
- WHEREAS, Article III of the Constitution of the Three Affiliated Tribes provides that the Tribal Business Council is the governing body of the Tribes; and
- WHEREAS, Article IV, Section 5(l) of the Constitution of the Three Affiliated Tribes provides the Tribal Business Council authority to adopt resolutions regulating the procedure of the Tribal Council and other Tribal Agencies and Tribal Officials of the Reservation.
- WHEREAS, The Fort Berthold Reservation contains a large potential workforce of underutilized and underemployed tribal members, both male and female, skilled and non-skilled; and
- WHEREAS, The Tribal Business Council of the Three Affiliated Tribes wishes to build the capacity and skill levels of that workforce with a program such as the CTER/NCCI Native Construction Careers Initiative in order to help bring increased economic and career opportunity to its tribal members both now, and in the future; and
- WHEREAS, The CTER/NCCI Native Construction Careers Initiative provides a partnership approach, in conjunction with the Department of the Interior Office of Indian Energy and Economic Development's PL 102-477 programs, to finding solutions to tribal unemployment and poverty; and
- WHEREAS, The CTER/NCCI Native Construction Careers Initiative will provide skilled training in the area(s) of General Construction and other Building Trades skills deemed priority by the Three Affiliated Tribe.
- **THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED,** That the Tribal Business Council of the Three Affiliated Tribes supports the CTER/NCCI Native Construction Careers Initiative and the Department of the Interior Office of Indian Energy and Economic Development's PL 102-477 programs, and hereby lends the support of the Tribe to this effort



which is designed to further the goals of economic and career opportunity on our reservation thus improving the quality of life for tribal members and their families; and therefore

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, The Tribal Business Council of the Three Affiliated Tribes respectfully request the Department of the Interior Office of Indian Energy and Economic Development's PL 102-477 Division of Workforce Development to work with the CTER/NCCI Native Construction Careers Initiative to expeditiously arrange for the soonest possible date for the above-mentioned training to occur.
