

RESOLUTION OF THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE THREE AFFILIATED TRIBES OF THE FORT BERTHOLD INDIAN RESERVATION

A Resolution Entitled: "Clarification of the motion entitled" Mortgage Rate for 210 Homes and BOC" regarding the Northern Lights Subdivision"

- WHEREAS, This Nation having accepted the Indian Reorganization Act of June 18, 1934, and the authority under said Act and having adopted a Constitution and By-laws pursuant to said Act; and
- WHEREAS, Article III of the Constitution of the Three Affiliated Tribes provides that the Tribal Business Council is the governing body of the Tribes; and
- WHEREAS, The Constitution of the Three Affiliated Tribes authorizes and empowers the Tribal Business Council to engage in activities on behalf of and in the interest of the welfare and benefit of the Tribes and of the enrolled members thereof; and
- WHEREAS, Article VI, Section 5 (l) of the Constitution of the Three Affiliated Tribes provides that the Tribal Business Council has the power to adopt resolutions regulating the procedure of the Tribal Business Council and other Tribal agencies and Tribal officials on the Reservation; and
- WHEREAS, The Tribal Business Council by resolution created the 210 home Initiative to build 210 homes on the Fort Berthold Reservation such homes to be divided equally among the six reservation segments and the Chairman; and
- WHEREAS, The Dream catcher Program located in the Northern Lights Subdivision is a program established for the purpose of creating homeownership opportunities for tribal members and was financed and constructed by the Tribes with the intent that home owners would assume their own individual mortgages under lease to own agreements with the Tribe; and
- **WHEREAS,** The Tribal Housing Services Program was established to promote affordable housing for enrolled members and has been directed to administer the Dream Catcher Program as well as the 210 Home initiative; and
- WHEREAS, The Tribal Business Council previously approved a motion on May 25, 2010 at a Special Tribal Business Council Meeting entitled "Mortgage Rates for 210 Homes and BOC": and
- WHEREAS, This motion was made to establish a set monthly payment for the homes to be constructed under the 210 Home Initiative specifically and did not include the homes constructed under the Dreamcatcher Program; and



- WHEREAS, The Fort Berthold Housing Authority, acting as manager of the Dreamcatcher Program, did authorize and instruct the participants of this program with homes located at the Northern Lights subdivision to reduce their monthly lease payment to \$400.00 pursuant to the above-mentioned motion; and
- WHEREAS, The Fort Berthold Housing Authority's authorization to reduce monthly payments for the Northern Lights subdivision participants was outside the realm of the approved motion and resulted in a substantial loss in the amount of the accounts receivable available to pay the actual mortgage payments which led to legal ramifications for the mortgage holder, namely the Three Affiliated Tribes; and
- WHEREAS, The Tribal Housing Services Program is now responsible for the administration of the Northern Lights subdivision and recommends that the required monthly payments for the lessees under this program be changed back to the actual mortgage payment less an established subsidy amount to be adhered by all parties per revised Lease Agreement and reviewed annually.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the Tribal Business Council does hereby clarify that the May 25^{th, 2010} motion establishing mortgage rates for the 210 home initiative was not intended for the Northern Lights subdivision participants to reduce their monthly lease obligations.

Housing services Program to enter into new Lease Agreements with the Northern Lights subdivision participants that increases the required lease payment to reflect the current monthly mortgage payments less an established subsidy amount per attached spreadsheet, to be reviewed annually.

BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED, that the Tribal Business Council hereby authorizes the Tribal Housing Program to access its funds from the Shakopee grant that are invested at Bremer Bank in Minot, ND to offset the cost of the monthly lease subsidy until such time that a refinance of the current mortgages can be negotiated.
