



**RESOLUTION OF THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE
THREE AFFILIATED TRIBES OF THE
FORT BERTHOLD INDIAN RESERVATION**

A Resolution Entitled: "Authorization to Pursue a plan for the Development of a New Headquarters for the Three Affiliated Tribes"

- WHEREAS,** This Nation having accepted the Indian Reorganization Act of June 18, 1934, and the authority under said Act and having adopted a Constitution and By-Laws pursuant to said Act; and
- WHEREAS,** The Constitution of the Three Affiliated Tribe generally authorizes and empowers the Tribal Business Council to engage in activities on behalf of and in the interest of the welfare and benefit of the Tribes and of the enrolled members thereof; and
- WHEREAS,** Article III of the Constitution of the Three Affiliated Tribes provides that the Tribal Business Council is the governing body of the Tribes; and
- WHEREAS,** The Constitution of the Three Affiliated Tribes authorizes and empowers the Tribal Business Council to engage in activities on behalf of and in the interest of the welfare and benefit of the Tribes and of the enrolled members thereof; and
- WHEREAS,** Article VI, Section 5 (l) of the Constitution of the Three Affiliated Tribes provides that the Tribal Business Council has the power to adopt resolutions regulating the procedure of the Tribal Business Council and other Tribal agencies;
- WHEREAS,** Article VI, Section 5 (c) of the Constitution of the Three Affiliated Tribes provides that the Tribal Business Council has the power to administer any funds or property within the exclusive control of Tribes and to make expenditures from available tribal funds for public purposes of the Tribes; and
- WHEREAS,** The number and size of the Three Affiliated Tribes governmental programs have increased dramatically due to the production of oil and gas on the Fort Berthold Reservation; and
- WHEREAS,** Several of the Three Affiliated Tribes, Tribal programs and offices are located throughout the city of New Town and the Four Bears Community; and
- WHEREAS,** Many Tribal programs are operating in isolated offices that are converted buildings that were not designed to be used as offices; and
- WHEREAS,** Inadequate office facilities make it difficult to manage Tribal programs and maintain moral among the Tribal staff; and



WHEREAS, The Three Affiliated Tribes does not have an area zoned and dedicated as Tribal Government headquarters; and

WHEREAS, The Tribal Business Council believes it would be in the best interest of the Tribes and its members to pursue plans for the development of a new tribal headquarters to meet the growing demand of the tribal government and infrastructure.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the Tribal Business Council of the Three Affiliated Tribes hereby authorizes the development of a plan to pursue a new Tribal Headquarters; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Office of the Tribal Chairman shall have authority to direct the development of the planning of this project; and

BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED, that the Tribal Business Council reserves the right to review and approve any plans for such development prior to the commitment or expenditure of any tribal funds.
