

RESOLUTION OF THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE THREE AFFILIATED TRIBES OF THE FORT BERTHOLD INDIAN RESERVATION

A Resolution entitled, "Re-contracting of Program Functions, Services and Activities related directly and indirectly to Adult and Juvenile Detention Operations, Inclusive of Administration and Management functions, commencing October 1, 2011 and Extending for an Indefinite Period of Time"

- WHEREAS, This Nation having accepted the Indian Reorganization Act of June 18, 1934, and the authority under said Act and having adopted a Constitution and By-Laws pursuant to said Act; and
- WHEREAS, The Constitution of the Three Affiliated Tribes generally authorizes and empowers the Tribal Business Council to engage in activities on behalf of and in the interest of the welfare and benefit of the Tribes and of the enrolled members thereof; and
- WHEREAS, Article III of the Constitution of the Three Affiliated Tribes provides that the Tribal Business Council is the governing body of the Tribes; and
- WHEREAS, Article VI, Section 5 (c) of the Constitution of the Three Affiliated Tribes empowers the Tribal Business Council to negotiate with Federal, State, and local Governments on behalf of the Tribe
- WHEREAS, Public Law 93-638, entitled the Indian Self-Determination and Education Assistance Act, provides for contracting mechanisms whereby Indian Tribes may elect to assume governmental programs, functions, services or activities which are otherwise performed by the Federal Government; and
- WHEREAS, the Tribal Business Council advocates the need to promote programs, functions, services and activities for which the Federal Government is specifically and ultimately responsible in a manner that would contribute to the general welfare and well being of the Three Affiliated Tribes and its members; and
- WHEREAS, in 2004 the Tribe entered into a PL 93-638 Contract with the Bureau of Indian Affairs for the purpose of administering adult and juvenile corrections and detention services on the Fort Berthold Reservation and has been administering said programs since that time; and



WHEREAS, the Tribal Business Council has determined it to be in the best interests of the Tribes to continue to administer those programs, functions, services and activities related to adult and juvenile corrections and detention services and to re- contract those programs under mature contract status, commencing October 1st, 2011 and continuing for an indefinite period of time; and

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the Tribal Business Council of the Three Affiliated Tribes of the Fort Berthold Reservation hereby requests to re-contract all programs, functions activities and services related directly or indirectly to adult and juvenile detention services from the Bureau of Indian Affairs; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Tribal Business Council of the Three Affiliated Tribes of the Fort Berthold Reservation further elects to deliver those program functions, services and activities related directly and indirectly to adult and juvenile detention services under a separately executed mature-status P.L. 93-638 Contract with the Bureau of Indian Affairs commencing October 1, 2011, and extending for an indefinite period, subject to Congressional appropriations; and

BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED That the Tribal Business Council hereby authorizes the Chairman to negotiate and execute any and all documents necessary to carry out the terms of this Resolution.
