

## RESOLUTION OF THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE THREE AFFILIATED TRIBES OF THE FORT BERTHOLD INDIAN RESERVATION

A Resolution entitled, "Health Care Education, Acupuncture Treatment And Massage Therapy Clinic"

- WHEREAS, This Nation having accepted the Indian Reorganization Act of June 18, 1934, and the authority under said Act and having adopted a Constitution and By-Laws pursuant to said Act; and
- WHEREAS, The Constitution of the Three Affiliated Tribes generally authorizes and empowers the Tribal Business Council to engage in activities on behalf of and in the interest of the welfare and benefit of the Tribes and of the enrolled members thereof; and
- WHEREAS, Article III of the Constitution of the Three Affiliated Tribes provides that the Tribal Business Council is the governing body of the Tribes; and
- WHEREAS, Article IV, Section 5(1) of the Constitution of the Three Affiliated Tribes provides the Tribal Business Council authority to adopt resolutions regulating the procedure of the Tribal Council and other Tribal Agencies and Tribal Officials of the Reservation; and
- WHEREAS, The Three Affiliated Tribes 21<sup>st</sup> Century Health Care Services
  Reform Project Phase I Report, March 2010 provided statistical data that
  determined Diabetes and Obesity an Epidemic on the Fort Berthold Indian
  Reservation: Recommendation #1, of the Report, recommended that the Tribe
  research and develop a comprehensive and holistic health and human services
  system that will combat diabetes and obesity. This system would encompass a
  coordinated effort of public health services such as prevention, intervention,
  hospice, grief and mental health counseling, health education, behavioral health
  education, etc.; and
- WHEREAS, In the years 2003, 2005, 2007, 2009 and 2010, Marilyn Youngbird
  The Ruseto Chinese School of Medicine (Boulder, Colorado) and
  The Genesis Health and Fitness, LLC (Lakewood, Colorado)
  established a Health Care Education and Acupuncture/Massage
  Clinic for diabetes, obesity and chronic pain on the Fort Berthold
  Indian Reservation and assisted more than 610 tribal members that were given
  acupuncture treatment and 270 members received massage therapy.

WHEREAS, Acupuncture is one of the most thoroughly researched alternative



medicine practices that involve the stimulation of specific points of the body to alter chemical neurotransmitters for therapeutic purposes, and Massage at injection sites may increase insulin absorption thereby decreasing blood glucose levels in people who have diabetes mellitus.

- WHEREAS, Doctor Zane Rising Sun, Medical Clinical Director, Elbowoods
  Memorial Center, suggests that the Acupuncture and Massage
  Clinics be held on the Fort Berthold Indian Reservation four times
  a year, once a quarter, to get an assessment how Acupuncture
  Treatments and Massage Therapy help prevent neuropathy,
  stimulates kidney function, reduces chronic pain and improves
  other related diseases caused from diabetes.
- THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, That the Tribal Business Council of the
  Three Affiliated Tribes is committed to continue the "War on Diabetes" declared
  by Chairman Tex Hall, in the Year of 2004, by providing alternative prevention
  and intervention medical treatment model for their tribal members
- THEREFORE BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Tribal Business Council of the Three Affiliated Tribes of the Fort Berthold Reservation Approves the Budget of \$18,713.00, for the Health Care Education, Acupuncture Treatment and Massage Therapy Clinic to be held in the Twin Buttes Segment and the Mandaree Segment.
- FINALLY, BEIT RESOLVED, That the Tribal Business Council of the Tribal Business Council Approves the Ruseto Chinese School of Medicine and Genesis Health and Fitness to establish a four day clinic on the Fort Berthold Indian Reservation at Twin Buttes July 3-4, 2013 and at Mandaree from July 5-6, 2013.
