

## RESOLUTION OF THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE THREE AFFILIATED TRIBES OF THE FORT BERTHOLD INDIAN RESERVATION

A Resolution Entitled: "Approving a contract to facilitate a process that will clarity and define best practices for payment of Health Insurance for all tribal members both on and off the reservation by the MHA Nation"

- WHEREAS, This Nation having accepted the Indian Reorganization Act of June 18, 1934, and the authority under said Act and having adopted a Constitution and By-laws pursuant to said Act; and
- WHEREAS, The Constitution and By-laws of the Three Affiliated Tribes was adopted By the membership of the Tribes on May 15, 1936 pursuant to the Indian Reorganization Act of 1934 and duly approved by the Secretary of Interior, and
- WHEREAS, Article III of the Constitution of the Three Affiliated Tribes provides that The Tribal Business Council is the governing body of the Tribes; and
- WHEREAS, The Constitution of the Three Affiliated Tribes authorizes and empowers the Tribal Business Council to engage in activities on behalf of and in the interest of the welfare and benefit of the Tribes and of the enrolled members thereof; and
- WHEREAS, Pursuant to the inherent sovereignty of the MHA Nation, the MHA Nation possesses the sovereign authority to establish practices on Tribal lands; and
- WHEREAS, The MHA Nations desires to have all tribal members receive health insurance that will provide them full coverage for all their preventive and illness needs; and
- WHEREAS, A study is necessary to determine the risk of providing health insurance to supplement the health coverage provided by The Affordable Health Care Act, The Indian Health Service and Federal Health Care Programs to assure full health insurance; and
- WHEREAS, PayneWest Insurance has submitted a "Consulting Agreement" to provide the services desired by the MHA Nation; and
- WHEREAS, The Management Team of the Elbowoods Memorial Health Center have consulted with the Payne West Insurance Team to review their capabilities and interests and desire to accept their proposed contract and terms; and
- **NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED,** That the Tribal Business Council accepts the request from the Elbowoods Memorial Health Center Management Team; and



NOW THEREFORE BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Tribal Business Council approves the contract with Payne West Insurance to facilitate a process that will clarify and define best practices for developing health insurance for all tribal members.

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## CERTIFICATION
