

## RESOLUTION OF THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE THREE AFFILIATED TRIBES OF THE FORT BERTHOLD INDIAN RESERVATION

A Resolution Entitled: "Approval of lease and funds for Missouri River Resources to participate in the drilling of the Halcón Resources 148-95-27B-34 Wells (Spotted Horn Field)"

- WHEREAS, The Mandan Hidatsa and Arikara Nation ("Nation" or "Tribes") having accepted the Indian Reorganization Act of June 18, 1934 ("IRA"), and the authority under said Act and having adopted a Constitution and By-Laws pursuant to said Act; and
- WHEREAS, The Constitution of the Nation generally authorizes and empowers the Tribal Business Council to engage in activities on behalf of and in the interest of the welfare and benefit of the Tribes and of the enrolled members thereof; and
- WHEREAS, Article III, Section 1 of the Constitution of the Nation provides that the Tribal Business Council is the governing body of the Tribes; and
- WHEREAS, The Constitution of the Three Affiliated Tribes authorizes and empowers the Tribal Business Council to engage in activities on behalf of and in the interest of the welfare and benefit of the Tribes and of the enrolled members thereof; and
- WHEREAS, Article VI, Section 5 (i) and Article IX of the Constitution authorizes the Tribal Business Council to lease tribal lands and resources, including minerals; and
- WHEREAS, The Tribal Business Council created Missouri River Resources (MRR) to participate in and profit from the oil and gas exploration on Reservation lands, and to ensure the MHA Nation receives the benefits of the natural resources that lay beneath its land; and
- WHEREAS, The Tribal Business Council finds it is in the best interest of the MHA Nation to lease to MRR 39.54 acres within a 1280 spacing unit located in the Halcón Fort Berthold Project/Spotted Horn Field at T148N, R95W, Sections 27 and 34 in Dunn County, ND for drilling and completion of three wells ("Wells"), two in the Bakken formation and one in the Three Forks formation, operated by Halcón Resources.
- WHEREAS, The Tribal Business Council finds it is in the best interest of the MHA Nation to authorize a loan to MRR in the amount of nine hundred seventy two thousand four dollars and 57/100 (\$972,004.57) to fund its 3.089063 percent working interest participation in the Wells.



NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, The Tribal Business Council authorizes the lease of property interests to MRR for drilling and completion of the Wells in the Halcón Fort Berthold Project/Spotted Horn Field located at T148N, R95W, Sections 27 and 34 in Dunn County, ND and operated by Halcón Resources.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Tribal Business Council authorizes and approves a loan to MRR in the amount of nine hundred seventy two thousand four dollars and 57/100 (\$972,004.57) to fund MRR's 3.089063 percent working interest participation in the Wells, to be repaid from MRR's share of production from the wells over a term not to exceed seven (7) years from the date production in paying quantities commences, and to be evidenced by a Promissory Note Executed by MRR consistent with the terms of this Resolution.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, the Tribal Chairman is hereby authorized to take such action as is necessary to carry out the terms and intent of this Resolution.
