

RESOLUTION OF THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE THREE AFFILIATED TRIBES OF THE FORT BERTHOLD INDIAN RESERVATION

A Resolution Entitled: "Authorization for a Partnership Agreement between the Three Affiliated Tribes and the American Indian Studies Research Institute."

- WHEREAS, This Nation having accepted the Indian Reorganization Act of June 18, 1934, and the authority under said Act and having adopted a Constitution and By-Laws pursuant to said Act; and
- WHEREAS, The Constitution of the Three Affiliated Tribes generally authorizes and empowers the Tribal Business Council to engage in activities on behalf of and in the interest of the welfare and benefit of the Tribes and of the enrolled members thereof; and
- WHEREAS, Article III of the Constitution of the Three Affiliated Tribes provides that the Tribal Business Council is the governing body of the Tribes; and
- WHEREAS, The Three Affiliated Tribes and the Nu'eta Language Institute of the Fort Berthold Indian Reservation desire to develop a comprehensive Nu'eta language curriculum and a multimedia reference dictionary in the language; and
- WHEREAS, The American Indian Studies Research Institute of Bloomington, Indiana has submitted a proposal to undertake task of developing a comprehensive Nu'eta language curriculum and a multimedia reference dictionary in the language; and
- WHEREAS, The Tribal Business Council has reviewed the proposal, now formally approves the attached agreement with the American Indian Studies Research Institute to complete the aforementioned project.
- THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, The Tribal Business Council of the Three Affiliated Tribes hereby formally approves the Professional Services Contract with the American Indian Studies Research Institute of Bloomington, Indiana to develop a comprehensive Nu'eta language curriculum and a multimedia reference dictionary in the language; and
- **BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED**, The total cost for the contract including travel shall not exceed \$283,715.65 unless approved in writing by the Tribal Business Council; and
- **BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED,** the Tribal Chairman and the Nu'eta Language Institute are authorized to execute this Professional Services Contract on behalf of the Tribe.

A PARTNERSHIP AGREEMENT

American Indian Studies Research Indiana, Indiana University, Bloomington, Indiana and Nu'eta Language Initiative, Three Affiliated Tribes, North Dakota

This document is an agreement of partnership between two educational organizations, Nu'eta Language Initiative (NLI), Three Affiliated Tribes, New Town, North Dakota, and the American Indian Studies Research Institute (AISRI), Indiana University, Bloomington, Indiana. The purpose of the agreement is to formalize the partnership between the two parties, who agree to collaborate in the development of a multi-year project, which will be implemented at the Fort Berthold Indian Reservation. This document sets the goals for the multi-year project and outlines the major parts of the program, and enumerates the products and services that AISRI will provide the Nu'eta Language Initiative.

Goal. The fundamental goal is collaboration between NLI and AISRI to develop (1) a comprehensive Nu'eta language curriculum for second-language learners of Nu'eta and (2) a multimedia reference dictionary in the language.

Duties and responsibilities. The content of the curriculum and the dictionary will be developed by the NLI staff, who will be working in close collaboration with the remaining speakers of the language. The draft versions of the lessons and dictionary entries will be forwarded to the technical staff at AISRI, who will edit the drafts and utilize their technical resources and professional layout skills to create both paper-based and interactive media versions of the final product.

Project Schedule. The project is scheduled to commence on March 1, 2015 until March 1, 2016. The agreement may be terminated by either party upon notification to the other party of its intent to terminate the contract at least three months prior to the date of termination. The agreement may be extended with express written consent of AISRI and the Tribal Business Council.

Project Funding. NLI is the primary party responsible for obtaining funding for this project on a continuing basis. NLI will also be continuously seeking outside funding to supplement program initiatives.

Ownership of Materials. The Three Affiliated Tribes shall own all materials and products developed in the course of this collaboration, including curriculum materials, computer activities, and related intellectual property. The Three Affiliated Tribes own perpetual exclusive rights to any and all materials created by the Consultant under the terms of this contract. The Tribe strictly prohibits the use of any of the materials without its express written consent. AISRI shall retain the right to use the methods, such as templates, designs, techniques, or processes used in developing the materials for the Three Affiliated Tribes for future projects on other language programs.

Assignment of Rights and Delegation of Duties. The rights and duties under this Contract may not be assigned or delegated by either party without the prior written consent of the other.

Entire Contract and Notification. This Contract contains the entire Agreement between the parties. This Contract may not be modified except by later written Contract signed by both parties.

Jurisdiction. This Contract was executed and is to be carried out on the Fort Berthold Indian Reservation. Any dispute arising under this Contract is subject to the jurisdiction of the Fort Berthold District Court.

Governing Law. This Contract is subject to and shall be interpreted in accordance with the laws of the Three Affiliated Tribes.

Compliance with Applicable Laws. The Consultant shall comply with all applicable Federal, State, and Tribal (i.e. TERO) laws and regulations in performing this Contract. Consultant shall also comply with all of the Tribe's policies, procedures, and rules.

Liaison and Contract Supervision. The Nu'eta Language Initiative Director shall be the supervisor over the Consultant and the Consultant's work.

Sovereign Immunity. Nothing in this Consultant Agreement shall be construed, held or interpreted as a waiver of the sovereign immunity of the Three Affiliated Tribes, its officials, agents or assigns.
