

RESOLUTION OF THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE THREE AFFILIATED TRIBES OF THE FORT BERTHOLD INDIAN RESERVATION

A Resolution entitled, "Tribal Business Council Approval for a Consultant for the Tribal Mitigation Plan, Through NDEMA."

- WHEREAS, This Nation having accepted the Indian Reorganization Act of June 18, 1934, and the authority under said Act and having adopted a Constitution and By-laws under said Act; and
- WHEREAS, pursuant to Article III, Section 1 of the Constitution and By Laws of the Three Affiliated Tribes, the Tribal Business Council is the governing body of the Tribes; and
- WHEREAS, The Constitution of the Three Affiliated Tribes authorizes and empowers the Tribal Business Council to engage in activities on behalf of and in the interest of the welfare and benefit of the tribes and of the enrolled members thereof; and
- WHEREAS, pursuant to Article VI, Section 5 (1) of said Constitution, the Tribal Business Council has the power to adopt resolutions regulating the procedures of the Tribal Business Council and other Tribal agencies and Tribal officials on the Reservation; and
- WHEREAS, The Three Affiliated Tribes currently does not have a Tribal Mitigation plan through the Emergency Management Agency. With a Mitigation plan the Three Affiliated Tribes would be eligible and able to apply to many more FEMA Grants, and
- WHEREAS, The Three Affiliated Tribes was eligible and has applied to the Pre-Disaster Mitigation grant application to the North Dakota Emergency Management Agency (NDEMA) in the amount of \$53,750, and
- WHEREAS, The Planning & Grants Department is in the pre-award stages, where we must meet all criteria as specified by NDEMA, and need to secure a consultant, and
- WHEREAS, This type of plan is an emergency response plan with few consultants that work with them. The person that we worked with was Carron Day of SANTEC, she was the person that assisted us with the numbers for the grant and the scope of work.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED: that the Tribal Business Council hereby authorizes Carron Day to be hired as the consultant for the mitigation plan contingent on the grant award, and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Tribal Business Council hereby authorizes the Tribal Chairman and Tribal Secretary to sign and certify all agreements, applications, and other documents necessary for said grant application.
