

## RESOLUTION OF THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE THREE AFFILIATED TRIBES OF THE FORT BERTHOLD INDIAN RESERVATION

A Resolution entitled, "Appointing the Liaison from the Three Affiliated Tribes to the North Dakota Petroleum Council."

- WHEREAS, This Mandan Hidatsa and Arikara Nation (the "MHA Nation"), having accepted the Indian Reorganization Act of June 18, 1934 and the authority under said Act, and having adopted a Constitution and By-laws under said Act, and
- WHEREAS, Pursuant to Article III, Section 1 of its Constitution and By-Laws, the Tribal Business Council is the governing body of the MHA Nation; and
- WHEREAS, Pursuant to Article VI, Section 5(1) of said Constitution, the Tribal Business Council has the power to adopt resolutions regulating the procedures of the Tribal Council, its Agencies and Officials; and
- WHEREAS, The Tribal Business Council has authority to engage in activities on behalf of and for the welfare and benefit of the Tribes and of the enrolled members thereof; and
- WHEREAS, The Tribal Business Council finds it in the best interest of the MHA Nation to formally engage the North Dakota Petroleum Council (NDPC) via a Tribal liaison; and
- WHEREAS, The NDPC is a trade association that represents more than 500 companies involved in all aspects of the oil and gas industry including oil and gas production, refining, pipeline, transportation, mineral leasing, consulting, legal work, and oilfield service activities in North Dakota, South Dakota, and the Rocky Mountain Region; and
- WHEREAS, The NDPC was created to promote and enhance the discovery, development, production, transportation, refining, conservation, and marketing of oil and gas in North Dakota, South Dakota, and the Rocky Mountain region; to promote opportunities for open discussion, lawful interchange of information, and education concerning the petroleum industry; to monitor and influence legislative and regulatory activities on the state and national level; and to accumulate and disseminate information concerning the petroleum industry to foster the best interests of the public and industry; and
- WHEREAS, The Three Affiliated Tribes have significant oil and gas resources that are currently in development; and



WHEREAS, The Tribal Business Council has determined that the Executive Secretary, Fred Fox, shall serve as the Tribal liaison to the NDPC and that the alternate shall be any other member of the Tribal Business Council as designated by the Executive Secretary for the Three Affiliated Tribes of the Fort Berthold Indian Reservation.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, the Tribal Business Council of the Three Affiliated Tribes hereby appoints Executive Secretary Fred Fox as the Tribal liaison to the NDPC, that the alternate shall be any other member of the Tribal Business Council as designated by the Executive Secretary; and
