

RESOLUTION OF THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE THREE AFFILIATED TRIBES OF THE FORT BERTHOLD INDIAN RESERVATION

A Resolution entitled, "Approving Safe Haven/Transition Home Contract – Twin Buttes/ South Segment"

- WHEREAS, This Nation having accepted the Indian Reorganization Act of June 18, 1934, and the authority under said Act and having adopted a Constitution and By-Laws pursuant to said Act; and
- WHEREAS, The Constitution of the Three Affiliated Tribes generally authorizes and empowers the Tribal Business Council to engage in activities on behalf of and in the interest of the welfare and benefit of the Tribes and of the enrolled members thereof; and
- WHEREAS, Article III of the Constitution of the Three Affiliated Tribes provides that the Tribal Business Council is the governing body of the Tribes; and
- WHEREAS, Article IV, Section 5(1) of the Constitution of the Three Affiliated Tribes provides the Tribal Business Council authority to adopt resolutions regulating the procedure of the Tribal Council and other Tribal Agencies and Tribal Officials of the Reservation; and
- WHEREAS, The Tribal Business Council has determined that the Twin Buttes/ South Segment has a need for a Safe Haven/Transition Home; and
- WHEREAS, The Tribal Business Council and its designated representatives have determined that Albino's Construction, LLC is awarded the contract to construct a Stick Built Home with a Full Completed Basement for the Twin Buttes Community, Twin Buttes, South Segment.
- THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the Tribal Business Council of the Three Affiliated Tribes hereby approves the construction contract with Albino's Construction, LLC, for the construction of the Safe Haven/Transition Home, Twin Buttes/South Segment; and
- **BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED,** the total cost of the contract shall not exceed \$259,616.00 for construction of a livable space of 4,256 square feet Stick Built home in the Twin Buttes Community, Twin Buttes/ South Segment.



BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED, that the Tribal Business Council hereby authorizes the Tribal Chairman and Treasurer to execute the construction contract with Albino's Construction to construct the 4,256 sq. ft., Safe Haven/Transition Home in Twin Buttes Community, Twin Buttes/ South Segment.

CERTIFICATION
