

RESOLUTION OF THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE THREE AFFILIATED TRIBES OF THE FORT BERTHOLD INDIAN RESERVATION

A Resolution entitled, "Approval of Loan for Thunder Butte Petroleum Services, Inc. for Operating Costs"

- WHEREAS, The Mandan Hidatsa and Arikara Nation ("MHA Nation" or "Tribes") having accepted the Indian Reorganization Act of June 18, 1934 ("IRA"), and the authority under said Act and having adopted a Constitution and By-Laws pursuant to said Act; and
- WHEREAS, The Constitution of the MHA Nation generally authorizes and empowers the Tribal Business Council to engage in activities on behalf of and in the interest of the welfare and benefit of the Tribes and of the enrolled members thereof; and
- WHEREAS, Article III, Section 1 of the Constitution of the MHA Nation provides that the Tribal Business Council is the governing body of the Tribes; and
- WHEREAS, Article VI, Section 5(1) of the Constitution of the MHA Nation provides that the Tribal Business Council has the power to adopt resolutions regulating the procedure of the Tribal Business Council and other Tribal agencies and Tribal officials of the Reservation; and
- WHEREAS, The MHA Nation has dedicated much time to the development of the MHA Nation Clean Fuels Refinery Project ("Project") near Makoti, North Dakota on tribal trust lands; and
- WHEREAS, The MHA Nation began construction on the Project; and
- WHEREAS, It is necessary for Thunder Butte Petroleum Services, Inc. ("TBPS") to secure three million dollars (\$3,000,000.00) to cover operating costs for the synthetic crude storage facility; and
- WHEREAS, TBPS has prepared the attached Promissory Note outlining the terms and conditions for TBPS to secure a loan for the operating costs from the MHA Nation; and
- WHEREAS, The Tribal Business Council has determined that it is in the best interest of the Nation to authorize and approve the attached Promissory Note for TBPS.
- NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the Tribal Business Council hereby authorizes and approves the attached Promissory Note to loan TBPS three million dollars (\$3,000,000.00) to cover operating costs for the synthetic crude storage facility.



BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, the Tribal Chairman is hereby authorized to take such other actions as are necessary to carry out the terms and intent of this Resolution.
