Motion made by James Hall and seconded by Ralph Wells Jr., that we separate the names of the voters according to districts.

Vote: 7 for, none opposed. Motion carried.

Twin Buttes: 33 voters

Motion made by Leland Hall and seconded by Thomas Bluestone that we grant Pete Coffey \$300.00 to move him to new place of employment.

Motion made by James Hall and seconded by Ralph Wells that Frederick Black Hawk's money be released to him in the amount of \$33.74.

Motion carried.

James Hall moved and seconded by Leland Hall to recommend to the Public Health that Bessie Holen be granted glasses under the school program.

Motion carried.

Motion made by Leland Hall and seconded by David Little Swallow that a resolution be drawn up to request \$50,000.00 for land acquisition. Motion carried.

Motion made by Leland Hall and seconded by David Little Swallow that we declare a moratorium on all supervised land sales until we are granted the above request. Motion carried.

Motion made by Leland Hall and seconded by James Hall that we advance Mervel Hall the balance of the land acquisition. Motion carried.

Motion made by Leland Hall and seconded by Ralph Wells that James Hall contact Isabelle Goodbird for more information concerning her land sale to the tribe. Motion carried.

Motion made by Leland Hall and seconded by Charles Fox that the request of renting house of Sarah Baker be left up to the land committee. Motion carried.
