Discussion was held pertaining to the objectives of Mr. Storch's contract. The Tribal Council proposed that the Wilkinson, Cragun and Barker Firm draw up a resolution and contract for Mr. Storch. Motion was seconded by Myra Snow. 6 for, 0 opposed, Chairman not voting.

Dr. Stern, Education Administrator: The Tribe is having difficulty in making decision for reservation principal, an education coordinator should be added and continue with the reservation principal. Principal. Principal should have a masters degree and three years experience in Admin. Educ.

Mandan: Who finances the Coordinator?

Stern: Write a project proposal request thru Title 1, for example OEO for this year, and next year thru 1740 funds. Coordinator should be on the level of GS-10 or GS-11 or same pay grade. The Tribe determines what the coordinator's duties are. There are coordinators at other reservations.

James Bluestone made a motion to readvertise the position of reservation principal. Motion was seconded by Tony Mandan. 6 for and 0 opposed. Chairman not voting.

Robert Fox made a motion to pass Resolution 70-112. Motion was seconded by Tony Mandan. 6 for and 0 opposed. Chairman not voting. (See attached Resolution)

Mandan made a motion that coordinator's salary be \$12,000 per year. Motion seconded by Nathan Lone Fight. 6 for and 0 opposed. Chairman not voting.

FHA

Land Utilization Program (See attached outline)

The FHA representatives requested that they have a committee to work with a smaller group, it would be easier to work with. The three members chosen for the committee do not necessarily have to be Tribal Council Members, also one BIA man (Realty) and Extension Agent. The committee will be the key people, their duties would be to decide what to do with the land and develop an overall plan with the money. The Tribal Council would make the final approval.

Bobby Bell was excused from the meeting since he had some important business to attend to.

Motion was made by Robert Fox to have the Tribe authorize a \$60.00 payment to Alonzo Phelen to haul the buffalos to Mandaree. Motion was seconded by Myra Snow.

Robert Fox made a motion to authorize Myra Snow to attend the meeting in Bismarck Thursday and have the Tribe finance her transportation expenses. Motion seconded by James Bluestone. 5 for and 0 opposed. Chairman not voting.

Bluestone requested to attend the meeting in Rapid City (National Council of Indian Opportunity)

Nathan Lone Fight made a motion that Tony Mandan and James Bluestone attend the NCIO meeting in Rapid City. Motion was seconded by Myra Snow. 5 for 0 opposed. Chairman not voting.

Myra Snow made a motion that the council meet with Johnson Omalley. Motion seconded by Nathan Lone Fight. 5 for and 0 opposed. Chairman not voting.

The Chairman suggested that James Bluestone attend the meeting in Chicago for Ina Hall and be paid for one day's expense and for Tony Mandan to write a letter of commendation for Ina Hall. Motion was seconded by Robert Fox. 6 for, 0 opposed. Chairman not voting.

Motion by Tony Mandan to adjourn the Meeting. Motion seconded by Bobby Bell.
