Item No. 3 MARY JANE YEAQHO LAND EXCHANGE APPLICATION

Motion No. 1 - Dennis Huber moved, seconded by Ernest Stone, to direct Addie Porter of the BIA to have Allotments 711A and 710A appraised, and to approve for land exchange with Mary Jane Yeaqho, for land exclusive of the Mandaree water pipeline, Section 2, T149, R94. VOTE: All in favor, motion carried.

Item No. 4 VERNON YEAQHO HOMESITE LEASE APPLICATION

Motion No. 2 - Ernest Stone moved, seconded by Dennis Huber, to approve the homesite lease application of Vernon Yeaqho, along with an electricity easement, Section 2, T149-R94. VOTE: All in favor, motion carried.

Item No. 5 GOLF COURSE RESOLUTION

Ernest Stone moved, seconded by Dennis Huber, to approve for referral to Council the resolution which will rename the Golf Course to the Antelope Creek Addition, and directing the Natural Resources Department to investigate the zoning and development aspects of this area, and that it will not be subject to Resolution 80-113. VOTE: All in favor, motion carried.
