Chairperson, Alyce Spotted Bear, called the meeting to order at 10:20 A.M. and appointed John Charging as Acting Secretary.

Celeste Eaglemen and Tex Lone Bear said they will have the work up reports on Goldie Fox, Keith Price, and Naomi Black Hawk, ready for the next Natural Resource Committee Meeing. Naomi Black Hawk's is already approved but, when it goes up before the Full Council, the Natural Resource Department should be ready to answer all questions, regarding this transaction.

ITEM 4 RANGE UNIT APPLICATION

MOTION NO. 1 - Moved by Gordon Blake, seconded by John Charging to approve Range Unit #24 for Roberta Dahlan and Lonnie Spotted Bear, contingent upon all requirements being met.

VOTE: Three (3) in favor, one (1) abstaining, motion carried.
