ITEM 1 CALL TO ORDER

ITEM 3 APPROVAL OF MINUTES

MOTION NO. 1 - Moved by Tillie Walker, seconded by Donald Malnourie to
approve the Judiciary Committee minutes of November 21, 1984 with no
corrections.

ITEM 4 JUVENILE OFFICER POSITION

MOTION NO. 2 - Moved by Donald Malnourie, seconded by Tillie Walker to
appoint Paul Good Iron to draw up a resolution and present it to the
Tribal Business Council for the reinstatement of the BIA Juvenile Officer
Position.

Buffalo, to attach to the resolution.

ITEM 5 CONVERTING OF THE TEMPORARY POSITIONS IN LAW ENFORCEMENT TO PERMANENT
POSITIONS

MOTION NO. 3 - Moved by Tillie Walker, seconded by Donald Malnourie to
write up a resolution to the Superintendent of the Bureau of Indian Affairs
and persuade the Superintendent to convert the temporary positions of
Laurie Young, Law and Order Clerk; Elton Poitra, Quentin Beston, and
Ken Dragswolf, Police Officers; into permanent positions. Present it
before the Tribal Business Council on December 6, 1984.

VOTE: Unanimous, motion carried.

ITEM 6 HEARING IN BISMARCK, NORTH DAKOTA

MOTION NO. 4 - Moved by Donald Malnourie, seconded by Tillie Walker to authorize travel for the Judiciary Committee members to attend a one hour hearing concerning Wold Remand - December 6, 1984.

VOTE: Five (5) in favor, two (2) not in favor, motion carried.

ITEM 7 MARIE WELLS LEFT THE MEETING AT 2:30 P.M.


ITEM 8 TRIBAL COURT ADMINISTRATOR

ITEM 9 ADJOURNMENT




