MOTION NO. 2 - Moved by Edmund White Bear, seconded by Gordon Blake to  
approve a Hay-cutting lease for one (1) year beginning January 1, 1985 and  
ending December 31, 1985 for the following described land: ALLOTMENT #531A,  
S<sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub>NW<sup>1</sup>/<sub>4</sub> 29-142-94, for 40 hay cutting acres at \$3.50 per acre; for  
Gainus Little Soldier.

ITEM 5 LAND EXCHANGE - QUENTIN AND BELINDA BESTON

MOTION NO. 3 - Moved by Gordon Blake, seconded by Edmund White Bear to approve  
and refer the land exchange between the Three Affiliated Tribes and Quentin  
and Belinda Beston to the Full Tribal Business Council for their approval.

REMARKS: The Bestons will receive two (2) more acres of land in the land  
exchange to reduce the difference.
