Bill Hale is requesting payment for damages to his round bales. Hugh Baker said that Jim Danks would be the ideal person to care for the Buffalo, since he is right there and can watch them around the clock. Hugh Baker felt that Terry Phelan was not able to care for the buffalo at this time.

VOTE: Unanimous-motion carried.

Hugh Baker entertained a motion for Natural Resource Department to move the buffalo to Schnell Livestock, moved to approve Delvin Driver, seconded by Edmund White Bear.

Discussion: Hugh Baker said the Pow-wows can to pick up their buffalo. Delvin Driver said the Santee Pow-wow Committee from Parshall will pay for one if they decide to have a pow-wow. Hugh Baker said he would get buy two buffalo.

VOTE: Unanimous-motion carried.

#### ITEM 12 ANG

Council meet with ANG staff members from the ANG plant of Bauleh. Employee Supervisor said that they have 41 enrolled members of TAT working at the plant. They would like someone from here to talk with the employees when they start having problems with attendance and other problems before being terminated. Eslie Thornton Jr., and Ivetta Spotted Bear will be the contact persons. Employee supervisor said they refer employee to Heart View for Alochol and Drug Abuse, they would pay for the treatment and also pay the employee's salary.
