Regular Meeting April 27, 1989

PRESENT: Hugh Baker, Chairman; Austin Gillette, Secretary; and Jim Mossett sitting in.

ABSENT: Ted Lone Fight III on travel.

OTHERS: Rich Schilf, Administrator NRD; Texx Lone Bear, Realty Officer; Dr. Alonzo Spang; BIA Superintendent; Roger Bird Bear, Paralegal; Gene White, BIA Roads; Mervel Hall; and Judy Black Hawk, Recording Secretary.

ITEM 1 CALL TO ORDER

Meeting called to order at 10:45 a.m.

ITEM 2 ROLL CALL Roll called by Secretary Gillette, quorum present.

ITEM 3 LAND SALE/MERVAL HALL
Discussion: Texx Lone Bear said he was asked to see
Lorace Hakansen to see if Lorace could give Merval Hall
more then he (Merval) asked for. Lorace Hakansen said he
could not go above the appraised value. Hugh Baker said
we have three (3) opinions: 1. talk to Lorace Hakansen 2.
get it reappraised 3. deferred payments (docket funds and
other funds). Austin Gillette said he would have to
go with the appraised value. (Myrna Jacobs joined the
meeting at 10:50 a.m.) Hugh Baker said the idea here is to
renegotiate.

ITEM 4 LAND EXCHANGE/HOWARD & LAVERNE FETTIG
Discussion: Hugh Baker said why should we want to trade
land in Bear Den to anyone. Rich Schilf said the land was
worthless. Hugh Baker said he did not agree to the
exchange because of the recreational development in that
area. Hugh Baker said we can give him a lease on it.
Hugh Baker asked Rich Schilf what the policy says on
trading land next to a recreational area? Rich Schilf
said you cannot trade if it is one mile from a
recreational area or adjacent to a recreational area.
Austin Gillette moved to disapprove base on the resolution
establishment priority for land trades. No second motion
dies.

TRIP REPORT
Discussion: Rich Schilf gave a trip report on the GISIRP
Coordinators meeting. Rich said we are in good shape to
have IRMP plan team start work in June or July, and try
and get training scheduled for the team members in July or
August.

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- ITEM 6 TRIP REPORT CON'T
 Rich Schilf said he was sending out letters to the team
 members who said they were interested and set up a meeting
 that would co-inside with the Natural Resource Committee.
 Rich Schilf said I would like to meet on May 10, 1989 with
 the Natural Resource Committee. Rich Schilf said a
 propose resolution asking for \$12,000 from the Water
 Resource will be brought up for full council approval
 tomorrow the money will be used for GRS and IMRP.
- TITEM 7 LEASE AGREEMENT SKUNK BAY/DANKS
 Austin Gillette moved to approve the lease agreement on Skunk Bay to Jim and Ed Danks, seconded by Jim Mossett.

Discussion: Rich Schilf said the concession agreement only covers the lease area. Rich Schilf said in talking to Kip Quale what we need to do is an act of the tribal ordinance imposing that tax. Austin Gillette said we want to tax all trailers even if they are on corp land. Hugh Baker said put a disclaimer that states no waiver of any governmental authority including the exercise to levelly taxes on other fees that are equitable.

VOTE: Unanimous-motion carried.

ITEM 8 LEASE AGREEMENT BEAR DEN TED LONE FIGHT JR.

Jim Mossett moved that the Tribe purchase John Morsette's land, seconded by Austin Gillette.

Discussion: Austin Gillette by leasing the land to Ted Lone Fight Jr. it would not cost him as might.

VOTE: Unanimous-motion carried.

Austin Gillette moved to approve a lease agreement on Bear Den to Ted Lone Fight Jr., seconded by Jim Mossett.

Discussion: Rich Schilf said Ted's lease agreement will have to be rewritten, giving him a share of the profits from the trailers. By the Tribe buying John Morsette's land Ted will have a savings for development.

VOTE: Unanimous-motion carried.

OIL AND GAS MINERAL SALE
Discussion: Rich Schilf said most of the oil and gas
leases were going to expire and a oil and gas mineral sale
was coming up. Hugh Baker directed Rich Schilf to start
with an oral action and go for the whole thing and if he
get one bidder that takes half, let him take that half
then go on with the rest of it. Austin Gillette moved
that the Tribe develop a plan as a resolve of the May 2nd
meeting, seconded by Jim Mossett. Hugh Baker said PR them
and see what they want.

VOTE: Unanimous-motion carried.

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ITEM 10 MR&I

Discussion: Rich Schilf said a meeting is scheduled with HKM tomorrow with the council. Rich Schilf said you do not want to give HKM a blanket approval tomorrow. The will meeting will be mostly discussion. Rich Schilf said Mandaree project has already been improved by the Council. Twin Buttes' project is not ready yet, maybe ready in a month or three weeks.

ITEM 11 ACP LEASE EXTENSION/WESTON SCHETTLER
Austin Gillette moved to table the ACP lease extension
until further research has done regarding the lease and
also recommendations, seconded by Jim Mossett.

Discussion: Rich Schilf said Weston Schettler picked the lease up at \$9.00 an acre and the lessee before him was paying \$25.00 an acre. (Ed Lone Fight sitting in at 12:05 p.m.) Weston Schettler picked up the lease saying he was going to put it into alfalfa. Rich said the land owner has to maintain the ACP or ASCS practice for five years if the Tribe agrees to Weston's request. Hugh Baker directed Rich to work with the Bureau on this and get their interpretation.

VOTE: Unanimous-motion carried.

ITEM 12 FARM PASTURE/HAY LEASE
Ed Lone Fight moved to approve a farm pasture/hay lease on
Allotment No. 828 at \$9.00 per acre to Austin Gillette,
seconded by Jim Mossett.

VOTE: Unanimous-motion carried.

ITEM 13 HOMESITE LEASE CANCELLATION/SHELLY YELLOW BIRD
Jim Mossett moved to approve the homesite lease
cancellation on Shelly Yellow Bird, seconded by Austin
Gillette.

VOTE: Unanimous-motion carried.

ITEM 14 DEFERRED PAYMENT/WILBUR HUNTS ALONG

Jim Mossett moved to approve a deferred payment for Wilbur

Hunts Along. No second motion dies. (Ed Lone Fight left
the meeting at 12:20 p.m.)

Austin Gillette moved for disapproval base on the track record of the Tribe not allowing any deferred payments, seconded by Jim Mossett.

Discussion: Rich Schilf said we have never did deferred payments for anyone. Hugh Baker said see if you can work this through CRP regulations.

VOTE: Unanimous-motion carried.

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ITEM 15 FEE PATENT REQUEST/YVONNE MERRICK

Jim Mossett moved to disapprove Yvonne Merrick's fee
patent request, seconded by Austin Gillette.

Discussion: Myrna Jacobs said the reason for the fee patent request is Yvonne cannot get a loan on her house because it is on trust property. Hugh Baker said work with Yvonne and see what her needs are. Austin Gillette said now she does not have to pay city taxes since it is back in trust property.

VOTE: Unanimous-motion carried.

- ITEM 16 HOMESITE LEASE

 Discussion: Hugh Baker said he wanted a report at the next meeting on whether the homesites fees have been collected, where the money is and also where is the money on tribal buildings in town.
- ITEM 17 LAND SALE/MERRIAM BULL EYE
 Discussion: Rich Schilf said a resolution is ready for full council action.
- ITEM 18 ADJOURNMENT
 Meeting adjourned at 12:35 p.m.
