ITEM 1 CALL TO ORDER

Meeting called to order by Chairman Baker at 10:09 a.m.

ITEM 2 LICENSE FEES FOR FEDERAL AND TRIBAL EMPLOYEES AND SPOUSES
OF ENROLLED MEMBERS

Discussion: Dan Eklund since the opening of Small Game
Proclamation and the opening of the upland hunting season,
I have had several people who work for the BIA or other
Federal State people who work on the reservation
inconjunction with the Tribe or under tribal program who
request that they be allowed to pay the enrolled members
fees for hunting upland game. Hugh Baker asked what the
difference was. Dan Eklund said there is about a \$20.00
for Non-members the cost is \$25.00 plus a stamp and for
enrolled members is \$6.00. Hugh Baker said he would
recommend that they pay the full price.

ITEM 3 SPECIAL DEER PERMIT

Hugh Baker approved a special deer permit for Rose Crow
Flies High and her family.

ITEM 4 ENDANGERED SPECIES PESTICIDES MANAGEMENT PROGRAM

Hugh Baker recommended the endangered species pesticides
management program for approval by Full Council.

Discussion: Dan Eklund will give a draft copy to each
council member for their review.

ITEM 5 CORRINE SAGE

Discussion: Ed Lone Fight said he received a letter from
Corrine Sage regarding Highway 22 Right-Of-Way. Ed Lone
Fight said Corrine Sage does not agree with the letter she
received. Rich Schilf said the BIA has to agree with the
appraisal. Ed Lone Fight said we can not have the BIA sign
off on the appraisal. Hugh Baker said find out what
offers were made to the other land owners. Ed Lone Fight
said we need to intervene, the appraisals are not accurate
they said there is a gravel pit there and there is no
gravel pit also they did not take in to consideration the
homesite, the spring. Rich Schilf will do a letter for Ed
Lone Fight's signature and a separate letter for Dr.
Spang.

ITEM 6 BRIDGE OPTION



ITEM 7 ADJOURNMENT




