Meeting called to order at 11:10 AM.

ITEM 03: ROLL CALL:

Roll call by Secretary Rabbithead.

Quorum Established. Prayer by Rev. Duane Fox.

ITEM 04: RESOLUTION/ESTABLISHING COMMITTEES: 92-104-JJR.

Resolution read by Secretary Rabbithead.

This resolution pertains to the appointment of Ivan Johnson as Vice Chairman, George Fast Dog as Chairman of Gaming and TERO Commissions, New members on TERO are Curtis Young Bear and Sam Meyers; New member on Gaming is Ivan Johnson; John J. Rabbithead, Jr., as Chairman of Human Resources Committee, Jeanette Coffey, Meredith Irwin and George Fast Dog as new members of the Housing Board. All other committees remain same. All committee actions to be concurred by Chairman

Wilkinson.

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ESTABLISHMENT OF COMMITTEES RESOLUTION (CON'T): Chairman Wilkinson entertained motion to approve.

Secretary Rabbithead made motion to approve, seconded by Vice Chairman Johnson.

Discussion: Mention was made of the regular order of business and Housing Board set up, also committee actions.

Vote: 4 for, 1 opposed, 1 not voting.
Motion Carried.

ITEM 05: RESOLUTION/WHITE SHIELD LAND & LIVESTOCK CORP:
Resolution read by Secretary Rabbithead.
Mr. Howard Wilkinson, who presented the resolution
was questioned if he had anything to add. He stated
that the corporation liked this area because of the
natural windbreak with spring available.

Delores White, Cattle Relending Program Officer stated this area is a historical site and the Corporation heard it was up for trade.

Discussion included under who's lease this is on. Suggestion was made as to establishing White Shield Land & Livestock Corporation as an entity first. It was mentioned that the Articles of Corporation was already in place and present.

Chairman Wilkinson stated first to recognize these people as a bonafide group and to make a decision on these lands identified.

Articles of Corporation read by Secretary Rabbithead

Chairman Wilkinson entertained motion to approve the Articles of Corporation for the White Shield Land & Livestock Corporation.

Councilman Gillette made a motion to approve, seconded by Vice Chairman Johnson.

Vote: 6 for, 0 opposed. Motion Carried.

Discussion on the lease. Change on resolution should be grant free <u>use</u>. The intent of the corporation is to lease this land after expiration.

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WHITE SHIELD LAND & LIVESTOCK CORPORATION (CON'T): Mention was made on the FMHA Land Purchase on these tracts.

Treasurer Bird Bear made a motion to table resolution until research is made on land tracts, seconded by Councilman Gillette.

Councilman Gillette made motion to approve recontracting, seconded by Secretary Rabbithead.

Vote: 5 for, 0 opposed, 1 not voting.
Motion Carried.

TTEM 07: RESOLUTION/EMPLOYMENT AND TRAINING SERVICES: 92-107
Resolution read by Secretary Rabbithead. This resolution pertains to the Three Affiliated Tribes expressing its interest in participating in the "Integrated Services Approach", authorizing JTPA Director to attend the developmental meetings.

Chairman Wilkinson entertained motion to approve.

Secretary Rabbithead made a motion to approve the resolution, seconded by Vice Chairman Johnson.

Vote: 5 for, 0 opposed, 1 not voting.
Motion Carried.

TTEM 08: FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE REQUEST/VETERANS:
Ron Rabbithead, Veterans Service Officer requested
assistance on behalf of the Byron Kulland Chapter
to attend a Veteran's Day Pow Wow at Poplar MT.
Councilman Mossett in at 11:40 AM.

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FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE REQUEST (CON'T):
Request was for four people at \$150 to \$200.00
apiece. This is a Veterans' activity representing
the Three Affiliated Tribes.

Chairman Wilkinson entertained motion for four people at \$200.00 apiece.

Councilman Mossett made motion to approve, seconded by Secretary Rabbithead.

Discussion was made.

Councilman Mossett withdrew his motion. Chairman Wilkinson acknowledged motion.

Secretary Rabbithead made motion to approve request seconded by Councilman Fast Dog.

Discussion on printout.

Vote: 4 for, 1 opposed, 2 not voting.
Motion Carried.

# ITEM 09: NDIEA CONTRIBUTION:

Bernadine Young Bird, Education Administrator stated this is a follow-up on a request that was made by the NDIEA. Bernadine was directed to meet with Treasurer Bird Bear regarding this request.

ITEM 10: NORTH CENTRAL HUMAN SERVICES-AGING PROGRAM:
Mary Dawn Sorum was not present however Councilman Mossett stated evaluation of Tribes' Aging
Services was done and the funding was cut short
at Twin Buttes because of shortcomings. A meeting
is scheduled on November 16 between the Chairman
and Mary Dawn Sorum. He stated Twin Buttes community would like to contract their Aging Services
separately.

Sanitary facilities discussed.

Chairman Wilkinson encouraged all Councilmembers to be present at the November 16 meeting with Mary Dawn Sorum.

The public was excused for a closed session. 11:55

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#### ITEM 11: ISSUES:

The issue was an altercation between two councilmembers. It was discussed with the Legal Department and the department recommended suspension of the councilmen involved for 30 days because council actions are reflections of the Chair, good or bad.

Chairman Wilkinson left the decision up to the other five councilmembers. Dismissal of suspension was recommended.

Chairman Wilkinson entertained motion to dismiss the proposed action with the stipulation that if it happens again with any councilman, disciplinary action will be taken.

Secretary Rabbithead made motion, seconded by Vice Chairman Johnson.

Vote: 3 for, 1 Opposed, 3 not voting.
Motion Carried.

Discussion: It was also recommended that a Code of Ethics be drafted immediately or as soon as possible as to what the conduct of the Council-members shall be.

Chairman Wilkinson acknowledges recommendation that the Legal Department draft up a Code of Ethics for Council review and approval.

Councilman Gillette made motion, seconded by Treasurer Bird Bear.

Vote: 7 for, 0 opposed. Motion Carried.

ITEM 12: RESOLUTION/RECOGNITION OF NORTH SEGMENT COMMUNITY BOARD: 92-108-JJR.

Chairman Wilkinson explained this resolution is asking the Tribal Business Council to recognize one board over the other. In the past, we have relied on the Segment Councilman, but there is two boards here. Resolution read by Secretary Rabbithead.

The recognized North Segment Community Board are: Chairman, Harley Lone Bear; Vice Chairman, Gordon Driver; Secretary, Sandy Eagle and Treasurer, Mary Elk.

Chairman Wilkinson entertains motion to approve.

Secretary Rabbithead presented education financial assistance request for Stephanie Foote, student at UND in the amount of \$400.00.

Fort Berthold NDSU Extension Service Agent, Mary
Fredericks who is taking a high school group to
Kansas City for a 4-H convention

Question is how many were Fort Berthold enrolled members. It was mentioned that the \$560.00 request be proportionately divided among tribal students.

Chairman Wilkinson entertained motion to approve.

Treasurer Bird Bear made motion to approve, seconded by Vice Chairman Johnson.

Discussion: It was suggested that \$100.00 be given to each Fort Berthold Tribal student.

Motion and second amended to reflect. Vote: 7 for, 0 opposed. Motion Carried.
