TRIBAL BUSINESS COUNCIL
SPECIAL MEETING \#21
April 19, 2001

1. CALL TO ORDER:

The meeting was called to order at 1:49 p.m. by Chairman Tex Hall, who asked all those present to remember tribal members who are less fortunate and have lost loved ones.
02. ROLL CALL:

Members present: Chairman Tex Hall, Councilman Spotted Beax, Councilman Fox, Councilman Wolf, Councilman Wells.

Absent: Councilman Phelan was not informed of the Special Meeting.
03. APRROVAL OF THE AGENDA:

Councilman Giliette motioned to approve the agenda as amended. Seconded by Councilman Wolf.

VOTE: $\quad 6$ Ayes, 0 Nays, 0 Abstentions, 1 Absent. Motion carried.
04. TNTERVIEF OF TAT TRIBAL DISTRICT JUDGE:

Councilman Fox motioned to appoint Peter Furseth for 90 days for the Chief Judge of the Fort Berthold District Court and to re-advertise the position until filled. Seconded by Councilman Wells.

VOTE: 6 Ayes, 0 Nays, 0 Abstentions, 0 Not voting. Motion carried.
05. FORT BERTHOLD DISTRICT COURT ADMINISTRATOR:

Councilman Fox motioned to direct the Court Administrator, Magdeline Young Bear to do an immediate analysis on the Tribal Court staff and formulate a plan of action with developed job descriptions, and submit for review on May 7, 2001. Seconded by Councilman Spotted Bear.

VOTE: 6 Ayes, 0 Nays, 0 Abstentions, 1 Not voting. Motion carried.

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06. TATT EMPLOYEE GENERAL ASSEMBLY:

Councilman Gillette motioned that a Employee General
Assembly be scheduled for 1:00 p.m. - 3:00 p.m. June 01, 2001. Seconded by Councilman Wolf.

DISCUSSION: All tribal employees will be instructed to attend the assembly with the Tribal Business Council members or be subject to disciplinary action. All schedules will be adjusted to ensure attendance. The agenda will include the organizational functions of the Tribe, the line of authority process, and Personnel Policies. The assembly will be scheduled at the 4Bears Casino and Lodge Special Events Center.

VOTE: 6 Ayes, 0 Nays, 0 Abstentions, 1 Not voting. Motion carried.
07. $1^{3 T}$ ANNUAL AWARENESS CONFERENCE FOR DRUG AND ALCOHOL: RESOLUTION \#O1-99MWJR:
Councilman Wells motioned to allocate $\$ 8,000$ to the $1^{\text {st }}$ Annual Awareness Conference for Drug and Alcohol to be held on May 29, 2001. Seconded by Councilman Fox.

VOTE: 5 Ayes, 1 Nays, 0 Abstentions, 1 Absent. Motion carried.
08. RARSEALL HEALTH CENTER: RESOLUTION \#01-100MNJR. Councilman Gillette motioned to approve a donation and grant of $\$ 35,000$ General Fund per past commitment of the Tribal Business Council. Seconded by Councilman Fox.

DISCUSSION: The funds will be used to equip the Health Center with furniture and fixtures.

VOTE: 6 Ayes, 0 Nays, 0 Abstentions, 1 Not voting. Motion carried.
09. NANETTE TWISS EDUCATIONAL LOAN:

Councilman Wells motioned to authorize payment not to exceed \$2,500 defaulted student loan of Nanette Twiss, at a repayment schedule of $2 \%$. Seconded by Councilman Wolf.

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DISCUSSION: The Tribal Business Council will review the Student Loan Education Policy and make amendments to include a defaulted category, set a cap on repayment to be paid directly to the vendor.

VOTE: 5 Ayes, 0 Nays, 1 Abstention, 0 Absent. Motion carried.
10. SIAUGGTEREOUSE PLANT LOCATED IN TEE PARSHALL AREA:

Councilman Fox motioned to direct the Comprehensive Economic Development to begin developing a proposal for a Kill-site and a slaughterhouse plant, and give a report to the Tribal Business Council on May 7 \& 8, 2001. Seconded by Councilman Wells.

DISCUSSION: The Legal Department will begin the research to develop a patent trademark.

VOTE: $\quad 6$ Ayes, 0 Nays, 0 Abstentions, 1 Absent. Motion carried.
11. FITNESS/EXERCISE PROGRAM:

Councilman Gillette motioned to rescind Resolution \#90-106mL in its entirety, and to rescind any other Resolutions that pertain to the Fitness/Exercise Program. Seconded by Councilman Spotted Bear.

DISCUSSION: Resolution \#90-106TL read: that the TAT hereby approves and encourages the tribal employees to utilize this fitness/exercise equipment for one hour during work time as stated. The reason to rescind Resolution $\# 90-106$ ts was that the one hour was being abused by tribal employees.

VOTE: 6 Ayes, 0 Nays, 0 Abstentions, 1 Absent. Motion carried.
12. IN HOUSE TRANSFER AND PROMOTION POLICY:

Councilman Fox motioned that any transfers be frozen until the Personnel Director brings the policy for review to possibly rescind. Seconded by Councilman Gillette.

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DISCUSSION: The Policy is being abused by Programs and under 99-33JJR, only the Tribal Business Council has the right to hire staff.

VOTE: 4 Ayes, 0 Nays, 1 Abstention, 1 absent. Motion carried.
13. PERSONNEL:

14. ADJOURNMENTI:

Councilman Gillette motioned to adjourn the meeting at 5:47 p.m. Seconded by Councilman Wolf.

VOTE: 6 Ayes, 0 Nays, 0 Abstentions, 1 Absent. Motion carried.
