- 01. Call to Order: Chairman Wells called the meeting to order at 10:46 a.m.

- **06.** <u>477 Update (Leo Cummings)</u> AmeriCorp VISTA Project Work Plan for Ft. Berthold Reservation. Leo is looking at establishing the AmeriCorp VISTA here on the reservation to develop resources center in our communities. The 477 program is requesting to apply for the grant from AmeriCorp VISTA but the tribe would have to match it with \$25,000.00 or \$30,000.00 this will be for FY/2005.

Councilman Gillette move to approve for the 477 program to apply for the AmeriCorp VISTA Grant and for the full 30% matching to refer to the full council. Motion seconded by Councilman Spotted Bear.

Commodity Program (Joe Henry) A letter of complaint was submitted by Melda Lambert that damage was done to her vehicle by the Commodity Workers of throwing boxes into her vehicle and is requesting \$900.00 to be paid. Commodity Director Joe Henry spoke with his staff concerning the complaint and they felt that they did not damage the vehicle. In their Job Description it does not state that they load up the commodities, for it is the responsibility of the clients to load up their own commodities.

The Commodity Workers only do this to help out clients that are unable to load them in. The two commodity workers Daryl Cummings and Lionel Chase apologized to Melda Lambert for the misunderstanding, Melda accepted their apology. No action was taken by the committee.

Councilman Gillette moved to approved for a 30-day appointment of Robert Chapin, motion seconded by Councilman Wolf.
