B. LAND/LIVESTOCK

Opposed to sub-leasing what is driving up grass prices Want it on record to how they feel about the matters.

Paul (comments) - looking for is a set of suggestions and overhaul that for the next grazing permit. Grazing lands have been exposed to diseases called tricomanisis. It has been exposed due to sub-leasing; some people want a waiver. List of suggestion from the Landowners association and will have his suggestion in writing and take all different suggestion and mold them into Land and Livestock and that everyone can live with this. The tribal council is going to be getting the brunt of this and asking for everything in writing and takes all this information. Want the total

concerns from Land and Livestock to take to the full council. May 15 is the cut off date.

- Want to have bulls checked to see if they are carrying the disease.
 Everyone right now is guessing and wants to make sure it is really here.
- Paul-authorize him to work with Mary and get this tested. ONLY thing they can do is prohibit him putting any animals out
- Mervin cannot prohibit but confine them
- Bulls will have to be confined and held for 3 three weeks and tested @ \$150 per bull

Councilman Hale have Paul and Mary research see what can be done and resolve this problem legally with Manual that research money that tribal council will designate money for his bulls to be tested, Seconded by Councilman Packineau

Discussion: Testing will not exceed \$1,500 Time limitation, Land & Livestock Association will donate a grand to help with problem to know it is at ease.

Morgan-asked Manual to sell his bulls that might be an approach they can go. It is his cows that would have to be neutral for four months. He might open cows that he might not know of.
